- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Arts Council; to amend section 13-208, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2016; to change
- 3 provisions relating to tax credits as prescribed; to define a term;
- 4 to create and provide uses for a fund; to provide powers and duties;
- 5 to provide for transfers of funds; to repeal the original section;
- 6 and to declare an emergency.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 13-208, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2016, is amended to read:
- 3 13-208 The total amount of tax credit granted for programs approved
- 4 and certified under the Community Development Assistance Act by the
- 5 department for any fiscal year shall not exceed three hundred fifty
- 6 thousand dollars, except that for <u>fiscal years 2017-18 through 2026-27</u>
- 7 fiscal year 2016-17, the total amount of tax credit granted under this
- 8 section shall be reduced by seventy-five thousand dollars.
- 9 Sec. 2. <u>(1) The Civic Engagement Cash Fund is created in the</u>
- 10 Nebraska Arts Council. The fund shall consist of funds transferred as
- 11 provided in this section and section 6 of this act, any other funds
- 12 appropriated by the Legislature, and funds received as donations, gifts,
- 13 bequests, or devises. Any money in the fund available for investment
- 14 shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the
- 15 Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment
- 16 Act.
- 17 <u>(b) It is the intent of the Legislature that seventy-five thousand</u>
- 18 dollars be transferred from the General Fund to the Civic Engagement Cash
- 19 Fund each fiscal year for fiscal years 2017-18 through 2026-27. The
- 20 Nebraska Arts Council shall use the Civic Engagement Cash Fund to award a
- 21 grant to the Nebraska affiliate of a grant-making body that provides
- 22 <u>financial assistance to organizations such as museums and community</u>
- 23 groups to conduct research, promote education, and provide community
- 24 resources for purposes of providing grants to eligible nonpartisan,
- 25 nonprofit civic engagement projects as defined in section 3 of this act.
- 26 <u>Transfers from the Civic Engagement Cash Fund are not authorized.</u>
- 27 Sec. 3. <u>For purposes of sections 2 to 6 of this act, civic</u>
- 28 engagement project includes, but is not limited to, promotion of
- 29 <u>volunteerism, nonpartisan voter registration activities and</u>
- 30 participation, civic education, equality and inclusion in community life,
- 31 <u>leadership development, nonpartisanship, diplomacy, civil discourse,</u>

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1 charitable giving, membership in community organizations, neighborhood

- 2 <u>organizations</u>, <u>and activities that increase confidence in civic</u>
- 3 institutions.
- 4 Sec. 4. Funds appropriated to the Civic Engagement Cash Fund
- 5 pursuant to sections 2 and 6 of this act shall not be used to fund (1)
- 6 any organization that engages in direct political advocacy for or against
- 7 a candidate, a ballot question committee as defined in section 49-1406,
- 8 or a political party, (2) activities that make direct or indirect
- 9 communications for or against a candidate for public office, a ballot
- 10 initiative, question committee as defined in section 49-1406, or a
- 11 political party, (3) activities supporting or opposing any individual
- 12 <u>seeking public office, a ballot initiative, or a political party, or (4)</u>
- 13 coordinating activities with a candidate for public office or a political
- 14 party or a campaign related to a ballot initiative.
- 15 Sec. 5. The Nebraska Arts Council shall report annually to the
- 16 Clerk of the Legislature regarding projects funded with grants from the
- 17 Civic Engagement Cash Fund. The report shall be submitted electronically.
- 18 The report shall cover the period July 1 through June 30 and shall be
- 19 submitted no later than November 1 of each year.
- 20 Sec. 6. (1) No later than July 15, 2017, the State Treasurer shall
- 21 transfer seventy-five thousand dollars from the General Fund to the Civic
- 22 Engagement Cash Fund.
- 23 (2) No later than July 15, 2018, the State Treasurer shall transfer
- 24 seventy-five thousand dollars from the General Fund to the Civic
- 25 Engagement Cash Fund.
- Sec. 7. Original section 13-208, Revised Statutes Cumulative
- 27 Supplement, 2016, is repealed.
- 28 Sec. 8. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 29 passed and approved according to law.
