1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend sections 49 and
2 50, Legislative Bill 327, One Hundred Fifth Legislature, First
3 Session, 2017; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the
4 provisions of Legislative Bill 512, One Hundred Fifth Legislature,
5 First Session, 2017; to provide an operative date; to repeal the
6 original sections; and to declare an emergency.
7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 49, Legislative Bill 327, One Hundred Fifth
2 Legislature, First Session, 2017, is amended to read:

29 Education Grant Program for at-risk children from birth to age three. It
30 is the intent of the Legislature that a maximum of five percent of
31 General Funds appropriated each fiscal year for the Early Childhood

1 Education Grant Program for at-risk children from birth to age three may
2 be used for evaluation and technical assistance.

3 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$100,000
4 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2017-18 and \$100,000 General
5 Funds provided as state aid for FY2018-19 for scholarships for early
6 childhood education providers.

7 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$69,000
8 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2017-18 and \$69,000 General
9 Funds provided as state aid for FY2018-19 for incentive bonuses for
10 providers of child care and early childhood education programs.

11 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$400,000
12 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2017-18 and \$400,000 General
13 Funds provided as state aid for FY2018-19 for the Nurturing Healthy
14 Behaviors program.

15 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$500,000
16 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2017-18 and \$500,000 General
17 Funds provided as state aid for FY2018-19 for learning community aid.

18 There is included in the amount shown for this program \$2,342,962
19 General Funds provided as state aid for FY2017-18 and \$2,342,962 General
20 Funds provided as state aid for FY2018-19 for programs for learners with
21 high ability.

22 Sec. 3. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2017.

23 Sec. 4. Original sections 49 and 50, Legislative Bill 327, One
24 Hundred Fifth Legislature, First Session, 2017, are repealed.

25 Sec. 5. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
26 passed and approved according to law.
