## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 6**

- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Office of the Inspector General of
   Nebraska Child Welfare Act; to amend section 43-4325, Reissue
   Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for release of a summarized
   final report as prescribed; to repeal the original section; and to
   declare an emergency.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 43-4325, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 43-4325 (1) Reports of investigations conducted by the office shall
4 not be distributed beyond the entity that is the subject of the report
5 without the consent of the Inspector General.

(2) Except when a report is provided to a guardian ad litem or an 6 7 attorney in the juvenile court pursuant to subsection (2) of section 43-4327, the office shall redact confidential information before 8 9 distributing a report of an investigation. The office may disclose confidential information to the chairperson of the Health and Human 10 Services Committee of the Legislature or the chairperson of the Judiciary 11 Committee of the Legislature when such disclosure is, in the judgment of 12 the Public Counsel, desirable to keep the chairperson informed of 13 important events, issues, and developments in the Nebraska child welfare 14 15 system.

16 <u>(3) A summarized final report of an investigation may be publicly</u> 17 <u>released when the Inspector General, with the chairperson of the Health</u> 18 <u>and Human Services Committee of the Legislature or the chairperson of the</u> 19 <u>Judiciary Committee of the Legislature, makes a determination that doing</u> 20 <u>so is in the public's best interest.</u>

21 (4) (3) Records and documents, regardless of physical form, that are 22 obtained or produced by the office in the course of an investigation are 23 not public records for purposes of sections 84-712 to 84-712.09. Reports 24 of investigations conducted by the office are not public records for 25 purposes of sections 84-712 to 84-712.09.

(5) (4) The office may withhold the identity of sources of
 information to protect from retaliation any person who files a complaint
 or provides information in good faith pursuant to the Office of Inspector
 General of Nebraska Child Welfare Act.

30 Sec. 2. Original section 43-4325, Reissue Revised Statutes of 31 Nebraska, is repealed.

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Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
 passed and approved according to law.
