- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to economic development; to amend section 81-12,154, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and section 81-12,163, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2016; to provide for a Bioscience Innovation Program; to provide duties for the Director of Economic Development; to create a fund; to prohibit certain appropriations and transfers as prescribed; to harmonize
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

provisions; and to repeal the original sections.

- 1 Section 1. (1) The Bioscience Innovation Cash Fund is created. The
- 2 <u>fund shall be administered by the Department of Economic Development to</u>
- 3 provide financial assistance to bioscience-related businesses applying
- 4 for financial assistance under the Business Innovation Act. Any money in
- 5 the fund available for investment shall be invested by the state
- 6 <u>investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the</u>
- 7 Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- 8 (2) The State Treasurer shall credit to the fund such money as is
- 9 (a) transferred to the fund by the Legislature, (b) paid to the state as
- 10 fees, deposits, payments, and repayments relating to the fund, both
- 11 principal and interest, (c) donated as gifts, beguests, or other
- 12 <u>contributions to such fund from public or private entities, and (d) made</u>
- 13 available by any department or agency of the United States if so directed
- 14 by such department or agency.
- 15 (3) Money in the fund shall be expended by the department as
- 16 provided in section 81-12,163 for the purpose of carrying out the
- 17 Bioscience Innovation Program.
- 18 (4) Up to five percent of the fund may be used by the department for
- 19 administrative expenses.
- 20 Sec. 2. The Legislature shall not appropriate or transfer money to
- 21 carry out the Business Innovation Act for any purpose other than the
- 22 purposes stated in sections 81-12,152 to 81-12,167, except that the
- 23 Legislature may appropriate or transfer money appropriated for purposes
- 24 of the act upon a finding that such are not being accomplished by the
- 25 Department of Economic Development. Any reappropriated funding for the
- 26 <u>Business Innovation Act shall be credited to the Bioscience Innovation</u>
- 27 Cash Fund on July 1 of each year.
- Sec. 3. (1) The Department of Economic Development shall establish
- 29 <u>a Bioscience Innovation Program under the Business Innovation Act. The</u>
- 30 purpose of this program is to provide financial assistance to:
- 31 (a) Support small enterprise formation in the bioscience sector of

- 1 Nebraska's rural and urban economies;
- 2 (b) Support the development of bioscience communities and economic
- 3 opportunity through innovation in biofuels, biosensors, and biotechnology
- 4 as it relates to animals, equipment, humans, industry, research, medical
- 5 and health information, medical and health products, medical and health
- 6 <u>services</u>, <u>medical diagnostics</u>, <u>medical therapeutics</u>, <u>and pharmaceuticals</u>;
- 7 (c) Enhance the creation of high-wage bioscience jobs to employ
- 8 graduates of postsecondary educational institutions in Nebraska and to
- 9 <u>attract graduate students from other states;</u>
- 10 <u>(d) Encourage the development of new technologies in the bioscience</u>
- 11 sector and the creation of new startup businesses focused on bioscience;
- 12 <u>(e) Leverage the state's agricultural sector to support the</u>
- 13 <u>development of emerging bioscience technologies impacting livestock</u>
- 14 operations and crop production; and
- 15 <u>(f) Leverage the bioscience research and development conducted at</u>
- 16 <u>postsecondary educational institutions in Nebraska to create private-</u>
- 17 sector bioscience enterprises.
- 18 (2) Private bioscience businesses and enterprises operating in
- 19 Nebraska shall be eligible for financial assistance as described in
- 20 <u>sections 81-12,157, 81-12,158, 81-12,160, and 81-12,161. A bioscience</u>
- 21 <u>business or enterprise receiving financial assistance pursuant to any of</u>
- 22 such sections shall provide a match of one hundred percent for such
- 23 assistance.
- 24 (3) The department may award up to two million dollars per year for
- 25 financial assistance from the Bioscience Innovation Cash Fund as provided
- 26 in section 81-12,163.
- 27 Sec. 4. Section 81-12,154, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 28 amended to read:
- 29 81-12,154 The purpose of the Business Innovation Act is to encourage
- 30 and support the transfer of Nebraska-based technology and innovation in
- 31 rural and urban areas of Nebraska in order to create high growth, high

- 1 technological companies, small businesses, and microenterprises and to
- 2 enhance creation of wealth and quality jobs. The Legislature finds that
- 3 the act will:
- 4 (1) Provide technical assistance planning grants pursuant to section
- 5 81-12,157 to facilitate phase one applications for the federal grant
- 6 program;
- 7 (2) Provide financial assistance pursuant to section 81-12,157 to
- 8 companies receiving phase one and phase two grants pursuant to the
- 9 federal grant program;
- 10 (3) Provide financial assistance pursuant to section 81-12,158 to
- 11 companies or individuals creating prototypes;
- 12 (4) Establish a financial assistance program pursuant to section
- 13 81-12,159 for innovation in value-added agriculture;
- 14 (5) Establish a financial assistance program pursuant to the
- 15 <u>Bioscience Innovation Act for innovation in biosciences;</u>
- 16 (6) (5) Establish a financial assistance program pursuant to section
- 17 81-12,160 to identify commercial products and processes;
- 18 (7) (6) Provide financial assistance pursuant to section 81-12,161
- 19 to companies using Nebraska public or private college and university
- 20 researchers and facilities for applied research projects;
- 21 (8) (7) Provide support and funding pursuant to section 81-12,162
- 22 for microlending and microenterprise entities; and
- 23 (9) (8) Provide support for locally owned and operated Nebraska-
- 24 based, high growth businesses by providing technical resources to foster
- 25 development, growth, and high wage creation. For purposes of this
- 26 subdivision, Nebraska-based, high growth business means a corporation,
- 27 partnership, limited liability company, limited partnership, or limited
- 28 liability partnership registered with the Secretary of State that has two
- 29 to fifty employees and has annual sales of no less than five hundred
- 30 thousand dollars and no more than two million five hundred thousand
- 31 dollars.

- 2 2016, is amended to read:
- 3 81-12,163 (1)(a) (1) It is the intent of the Legislature to
- 4 appropriate seven million dollars from the General Fund to the department
- 5 for the Business Innovation Act for each of fiscal years 2015-16 and
- 6 2016-17.
- 7 (b) It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate two million
- 8 <u>dollars from the Bioscience Innovation Cash Fund to the department for</u>
- 9 the Business Innovation Act for each of fiscal years 2017-18 and 2018-19.
- 10 (2) Up to five percent of the funds appropriated may be used by the
- 11 department, or by a nonprofit entity with which the department contracts,
- 12 for administrative expenses.
