- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to adopt the Empowerment Savings
- 2 Account Act.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Sections 1 to 9 of this act shall be known and may be

- 2 cited as the Empowerment Savings Account Act.
- 3 Sec. 2. For purposes of the Empowerment Savings Account Act:
- 4 (1) Department means the State Department of Education; and
- 5 (2) Eligible student means any student who is enrolled in
- 6 <u>kindergarten through grade twelve</u>, attends a school classified at the
- 7 lowest performance level established by the State Board of Education
- 8 <u>under section 79-760.06</u>, and is eligible to receive free or reduced-price
- 9 lunches under United States Department of Agriculture child nutrition
- 10 programs as such programs existed on January 1, 2018.
- 11 Sec. 3. The parent or guardian of an eligible student may apply to
- 12 <u>the department to have the department establish an empowerment savings</u>
- 13 <u>account on behalf of such eligible student. The parent or guardian of</u>
- 14 <u>such eligible student shall have access to such account via a debit card</u>
- 15 connected to the eligible student's name.
- 16 Sec. 4. Beginning with the 2019-20 school year, a school district
- 17 shall pay an amount equal to three percent of the anticipated state
- 18 average per pupil spending into each empowerment savings account
- 19 <u>established on behalf of an eligible student residing in such school</u>
- 20 <u>district. Such amount shall be paid in one payment each year on or before</u>
- 21 the first Friday in September. Such payments shall be made from funds
- 22 available to the school district. The district shall not seek additional
- 23 revenue to fund such payments.
- 24 Sec. 5. Beginning with the 2019-20 school year, the parent or
- 25 guardian of an eligible student on whose behalf an empowerment savings
- 26 <u>account has been established may use the funds in such account until the</u>
- 27 last day of the school fiscal year as defined in section 79-1091 for the
- 28 following expenses:
- 29 <u>(1) Online programs approved by the department;</u>
- 30 <u>(2) Educational therapy or services;</u>
- 31 (3) Tutoring services;

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- 1 (4) Testing fees; and
- 2 (5) Bank fees charged for the management of an empowerment savings
- 3 account.
- 4 Parents or guardians shall provide itemized receipts from all
- 5 purchases made from such account to the school district in which such
- 6 eligible student is enrolled.
- 7 Sec. 6. A school district having one or more eligible students
- 8 <u>shall notify each eligible student's parent or guardian that such student</u>
- 9 is an eligible student pursuant to the Empowerment Savings Account Act.
- 10 Sec. 7. (1) Any funds remaining in an empowerment savings account
- on the last day of a school fiscal year as defined in section 79-1091
- 12 <u>shall be returned to the school district which made the deposit required</u>
- 13 by section 4 of this act.
- 14 (2) If a school is no longer classified at the lowest performance
- 15 level established by the State Board of Education or if the student is no
- 16 <u>longer an eligible student, the empowerment savings account connected to</u>
- 17 <u>such student's name shall be closed by the state board at the end of the</u>
- 18 <u>last school year in which such student was an eligible student.</u>
- 19 Sec. 8. A school district in which one or more eligible students is
- 20 <u>enrolled shall maintain records of all expenditures from each empowerment</u>
- 21 savings account and keep the records on file for audit purposes. Such
- 22 records shall include the name of the person making the expenditure, the
- 23 name of the eligible student, the purchaser's relationship to the
- 24 eligible student, the item or items purchased, and the date of purchase.
- 25 Such records shall be audited in conjunction with the annual audit
- 26 required pursuant to section 79-1089.
- 27 Sec. 9. <u>The department may adopt and promulgate rules and</u>
- 28 regulations to carry out the Empowerment Savings Account Act.
