1	A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Civic and Community Center Financing
2	Act; to amend sections 13-2703 and 13-2707, Revised Statutes
3	Cumulative Supplement, 2016, and section 13-2705, Revised Statutes
4	Supplement, 2017; to redefine terms; to expand the use of the Civic
5	and Community Center Financing Fund; to change grant request limits
6	as prescribed; to provide a restriction on the sale of certain
7	municipally owned centers; to provide priority for certain grant
8	applications as prescribed; and to repeal the original sections.
9	Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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Section 1. Section 13-2703, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2016, is amended to read:

3 13-2703 For purposes of the Civic and Community Center Financing4 Act:

5 (1) Civic center means a facility that is primarily used to host6 conventions, meetings, and cultural events and a library;

7 (2) Community center means <u>property that is owned by a municipality</u> 8 <u>and located within the traditional center of a community, typically</u> 9 comprised of a cohesive core of residential, civic, religious, and 10 commercial buildings, arranged around a main street and intersecting 11 streets;

12 (3) Department means the Department of Economic Development;

(4) Fund means the Civic and Community Center Financing Fund;

(5) Historic building <u>or district</u> means a building <u>or district</u>
eligible for listing on or currently listed on the National Register of
Historic Places; and

(6) Recreation center means a facility <u>or park</u> used for athletics,
fitness, sport activities, or recreation that is owned by a municipality
and is available for use by the general public with or without charge.
Recreation center does not include any facility that requires a person to
purchase a membership to utilize such facility.

22 Sec. 2. Section 13-2705, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2017, is 23 amended to read:

24 13-2705 The department may conditionally approve grants of 25 assistance from the fund to eligible and competitive applicants within 26 the following limits:

27 (1) Except as provided in subdivision (2) of this section, a grant
28 request shall be in an amount meeting the following requirements:

(a) For a grant of assistance under section 13-2704.01, at least
 <u>fifteen</u> thousand dollars but no more than:

31 (i) For a city of the primary class, <u>two</u> one million <u>two</u> five

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hundred <u>fifty</u> thousand dollars;

2 (ii) For a city with a population of more than forty thousand but less than one hundred thousand inhabitants as determined by the most 3 recent federal decennial census or the most recent revised certified 4 5 count by the United States Bureau of the Census, one million one hundred twenty-five seven hundred fifty thousand dollars; 6

7 (iii) For a city with a population of more than twenty thousand but less than forty thousand inhabitants as determined by the most recent 8 9 federal decennial census or the most recent revised certified count by the United States Bureau of the Census, seven hundred fifty five hundred 10 thousand dollars; 11

(iv) For a city with a population of more than ten thousand but less 12 13 than twenty thousand inhabitants as determined by the most recent federal decennial census or the most recent revised certified count by the United 14 States Bureau of the Census, \underline{six} four hundred thousand dollars; and 15

(v) For a municipality with a population of less than ten thousand 16 17 inhabitants as determined by the most recent federal decennial census or the most recent revised certified count by the United States Bureau of 18 the Census, three two hundred seventy-five fifty thousand dollars; and 19

(b) For a grant of assistance under section 13-2704.02, at least 20 three two thousand dollars but no more than <u>fifteen</u> thousand dollars; 21 (2) Upon the balance of the fund reaching three two million seven 22 five hundred fifty thousand dollars, and until the balance of the fund 23 24 falls below one million five hundred thousand dollars, a grant request 25 shall be in an amount meeting the following requirements:

(a) For a grant of assistance under section 13-2704.01, at least 26 fifteen ten thousand dollars but no more than: 27

28 (i) For a city of the primary class, three two million three two hundred seventy-five fifty thousand dollars; 29

(ii) For a city with a population of more than forty thousand but 30 less than one hundred thousand inhabitants as determined by the most 31

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recent federal decennial census or the most recent revised certified
 count by the United States Bureau of the Census, one million <u>six</u> one
 hundred <u>eighty-seven</u> twenty-five thousand dollars;

4 (iii) For a city with a population of more than twenty thousand but 5 less than forty thousand inhabitants as determined by the most recent 6 federal decennial census or the most recent revised certified count by 7 the United States Bureau of the Census, <u>one million one</u> seven hundred 8 <u>twenty-five fifty</u> thousand dollars;

9 (iv) For a city with a population of more than ten thousand but less 10 than twenty thousand inhabitants as determined by the most recent federal 11 decennial census or the most recent revised certified count by the United 12 States Bureau of the Census, <u>nine</u> six hundred thousand dollars; and

(v) For a municipality with a population of less than ten thousand inhabitants as determined by the most recent federal decennial census or the most recent revised certified count by the United States Bureau of the Census, <u>five</u> three hundred <u>sixty-two</u> seventy-five thousand dollars; and

(b) For a grant of assistance under section 13-2704.02, at least
 <u>three</u> two thousand dollars but no more than <u>fifteen</u> thousand dollars;

(3) Assistance from the fund shall not amount to more than fifty
 percent of the cost of the project for which a grant is requested; and

22 (4) A municipality shall not be awarded more than one grant of 23 assistance under section 13-2704.01 and one grant of assistance under 24 section 13-2704.02 in any <u>two-year</u> five-year period; and -

(5) A municipality shall not sell any civic, community, or
 recreation center that received grant funds for at least five years under
 the Civic and Community Center Financing Act.

Sec. 3. Section 13-2707, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
29 2016, is amended to read:

30 13-2707 (1) The department shall evaluate all applications for
 31 grants of assistance under section 13-2704.01 based on the following

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1 criteria, which are listed in no particular order of preference:

2 (a) Retention Impact. Funding decisions by the department shall be 3 based on the likelihood of the project retaining existing residents in 4 the community where the project is located, developing, sustaining, and 5 fostering community connections, and enhancing the potential for economic 6 growth in a manner that will sustain the quality of life and promote 7 long-term economic development;

8 (b) New Resident Impact. Funding decisions by the department shall 9 be based on the likelihood of the project attracting new residents to the 10 community where the project is located;

(c) Visitor Impact. Funding decisions by the department shall be based on the likelihood of the project enhancing or creating an attraction that would increase the potential of visitors to the community where the project is located from inside and outside the state;

(d) Readiness. The applicant's fiscal and economic capacity to
finance the local share and ability to proceed and implement its plan and
operate the civic center, community center, or recreation center; and

(e) Project Planning. Projects with completed technical assistance
and feasibility studies shall be preferred to those with no prior
planning.

(2) The department shall give priority to applications from
 municipalities which have not received a grant of assistance under
 section 13-2704.01 within the last ten years.

(3) (2) Any grant of assistance under section 13-2704.01 shall be
 matched at least equally from local sources. At least fifty percent of
 the local match must be in cash.

(4) (3) To receive a grant of assistance under section 13-2704.01,
 the project for which the grant is requested shall be located in the
 municipality that applies for the grant.
