## **LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 289CA**

PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

Introduced by Krist, 10.

Read first time January 17, 2018

1 THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIFTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, SECOND 2 SESSION, RESOLVE THAT:

3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2018, the following 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:

6 To amend Article III, section 5, and add new sections 31 and 32 to 7 Article III:

III-5 The Legislature shall by law determine the number of members 8 to be elected and divide the state into legislative districts as provided 9 in section 31 of this Article. In the creation of such districts, any 10 county that contains population sufficient to entitle it to two or more 11 members of the Legislature shall be divided into separate and distinct 12 13 legislative districts subject to section 31 of this Article , as nearly 14 equal in population as may be and composed of contiguous and compact territory. One member of the Legislature shall be elected from each such 15 district. The basis of apportionment shall be the population excluding 16 aliens, as shown by the next preceding federal census. The Legislature 17 shall redistrict the state after each federal decennial census. In any 18 such redistricting, county lines shall be followed whenever practicable, 19 but other established lines may be followed at the discretion of the 20 21 Legislature subject to section 31 of this Article.

<u>III-31 (1)(a) The Legislature shall not draw boundaries for a</u>
 <u>legislative district which individually or aggregately:</u>

1	<u>(i) Intentionally favor or disfavor an incumbent or a political</u>
2	party; or
3	(ii) Intentionally or effectively deny racial or language minorities
4	the equal opportunity to participate in the political process or
5	intentionally or effectively diminish their ability to elect
6	representatives of their choice; and
7	(b) The Legislature shall draw boundaries for a legislative district
8	which create a contiguous district.
9	(2) Unless compliance with the following standards conflicts with
10	the standards in subsection (1) of this section or with federal law, the
11	Legislature shall draw boundaries for a legislative district which:
12	<u>(a) Create a compact district;</u>
13	<u>(b) Create a district as nearly equal in population as is</u>
14	practicable to all other legislative districts; and
15	(c) Where feasible, create a district using existing political and
16	geographical boundaries.
17	(3) The order in which the standards in subsections (1) and (2) of
18	this section are set forth shall not be interpreted to establish any
19	priority of one standard over another within the respective subsection.
20	<u>III-32</u> (1)(a) Boundaries for a congressional district shall not be
21	drawn which individually or aggregately:
22	<u>(i) Intentionally favor or disfavor an incumbent or a political</u>
23	party; or
24	(ii) Intentionally or effectively deny racial or language minorities
25	the equal opportunity to participate in the political process or
26	intentionally or effectively diminish their ability to elect
27	representatives of their choice; and
28	<u>(b) Boundaries for a congressional district shall be drawn to create</u>
29	<u>a contiguous district.</u>
30	(2) Unless compliance with the following standards conflicts with
31	the standards in subsection (1) of this section or with federal law,

1 <u>boundaries for a congressional district shall be drawn which:</u>

2 <u>(a) Create a compact district;</u>

3 <u>(b) Create a district as nearly equal in population as is</u>

4 practicable to all other congressional districts in Nebraska; and

5 (c) Where feasible, create a district using existing political and
6 geographical boundaries.

7 (3) The order in which the standards in subsections (1) and (2) of
8 this section are set forth shall not be interpreted to establish any
9 priority of one standard over another within the respective subsection.

Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI, section 1, with the following ballot language:

A constitutional amendment to provide, change, and eliminate standards for drawing boundaries of legislative districts and provide standards for drawing boundaries of congressional districts.
