**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 367 clarifies the payment of costs for transportation. Since major juvenile justice reform efforts of LB 561 (2013) and LB 464 (2014), the service related “cost of care and treatment” responsibility has been interpreted differently by a variety of stakeholders.

The service related reform efforts did not change provisions related to the detention intake process outlined in Neb.Reb.Stat. § 43-250. Additionally, the role of juvenile probation as community support and supervision does not constitute probation having legal or physical “custody” of youth who have been adjudicated and/or those being supervised.
