

LEGISLATIVE BILL 198

Approved by the Governor February 14, 2018

Introduced by McCollister, 20.

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Crimes Against Children Fund; to amend section 81-1429.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to terminate the fund; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 81-1429.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is amended to read:

81-1429.01 There is hereby created the Crimes Against Children Fund. The fund shall be appropriated by the Legislature and administered by the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice for the purpose of reducing the expenses incurred by county attorneys in consulting with and retaining expert witnesses and other costs in the investigation and prosecution of crimes against children. Any money in the fund available for investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act. The fund terminates on the effective date of this act and the State Treasurer shall transfer any money in the fund on such date to the General Fund.

Sec. 2. Original section 81-1429.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is repealed.
