- 3 Section 1. Section 77-3,110, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
- 4 is amended to read:
- 5 77-3,110 (1) All funds received pursuant to sections 77-3,109 and
- 6 77-3,118 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the
- 7 Department of Revenue Miscellaneous Receipts Fund which is hereby
- 8 created. The fund shall also include any money credited to the fund under
- 9 section 77-2703. All money in the fund shall be administered by the
- 10 Department of Revenue and shall be used <u>as follows:</u>
- 11 (a) Any money credited to the fund under section 77-2703 shall be
- 12 <u>used by the Department of Revenue to defray the costs incurred to</u>
- 13 <u>implement this legislative bill; and</u>
- 14 <u>(b) All other funds shall be used</u> to defray the cost of production
- 15 of the publications listed in section 77-3,109 or of the listings
- 16 described in section 77-3,118.
- 17 (2) Transfers , except that transfers may be made from the fund to
- 18 the General Fund at the direction of the Legislature. Any money in the
- 19 Department of Revenue Miscellaneous Receipts Fund available for
- 20 investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to
- 21 the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds
- 22 Investment Act.
- 23 Sec. 2. Section 77-2703, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 24 amended to read:
- 25 77-2703 (1) There is hereby imposed a tax at the rate provided in
- 26 section 77-2701.02 upon the gross receipts from all sales of tangible
- 27 personal property sold at retail in this state; the gross receipts of

every person engaged as a public utility, as a community antenna 1 television service operator, or as a satellite service operator, any 2 3 person involved in the connecting and installing of the services defined in subdivision (2)(a), (b), (d), or (e) of section 77-2701.16, or every 4 5 person engaged as a retailer of intellectual or entertainment properties 6 referred to in subsection (3) of section 77-2701.16; the gross receipts 7 from the sale of admissions in this state; the gross receipts from the 8 sale of warranties, guarantees, service agreements, or maintenance 9 agreements when the items covered are subject to tax under this section; beginning January 1, 2008, the gross receipts from the sale of bundled 10 11 transactions when one or more of the products included in the bundle are 12 taxable; the gross receipts from the provision of services defined in subsection (4) of section 77-2701.16; and the gross receipts from the 13 14 sale of products delivered electronically as described in subsection (9) 15 of section 77-2701.16. Except as provided in section 77-2701.03, when there is a sale, the tax shall be imposed at the rate in effect at the 16 17 time the gross receipts are realized under the accounting basis used by the retailer to maintain his or her books and records. 18

- 19 (a) The tax imposed by this section shall be collected by the
 20 retailer from the consumer. It shall constitute a part of the purchase
 21 price and until collected shall be a debt from the consumer to the
 22 retailer and shall be recoverable at law in the same manner as other
 23 debts. The tax required to be collected by the retailer from the consumer
 24 constitutes a debt owed by the retailer to this state.
- 25 (b) It is unlawful for any retailer to advertise, hold out, or state
 26 to the public or to any customer, directly or indirectly, that the tax or
 27 part thereof will be assumed or absorbed by the retailer, that it will
 28 not be added to the selling, renting, or leasing price of the property
 29 sold, rented, or leased, or that, if added, it or any part thereof will
 30 be refunded. The provisions of this subdivision shall not apply to a
 31 public utility.

- 1 (c) The tax required to be collected by the retailer from the 2 purchaser, unless otherwise provided by statute or by rule and regulation 3 of the Tax Commissioner, shall be displayed separately from the list 4 price, the price advertised in the premises, the marked price, or other 5 price on the sales check or other proof of sales, rentals, or leases.
- 6 (d) For the purpose of more efficiently securing the payment, 7 collection, and accounting for the sales tax and for the convenience of 8 the retailer in collecting the sales tax, it shall be the duty of the Tax 9 Commissioner to provide a schedule or schedules of the amounts to be collected from the consumer or user to effectuate the computation and 10 11 collection of the tax imposed by the Nebraska Revenue Act of 1967. Such 12 schedule or schedules shall provide that the tax shall be collected from the consumer or user uniformly on sales according to brackets based on 13 14 sales prices of the item or items. Retailers may compute the tax due on 15 any transaction on an item or an invoice basis. The rounding rule provided in section 77-3,117 applies. 16
- (e) The use of tokens or stamps for the purpose of collecting or enforcing the collection of the taxes imposed in the Nebraska Revenue Act of 1967 or for any other purpose in connection with such taxes is prohibited.
- 21 (f) For the purpose of the proper administration of the provisions 22 of the Nebraska Revenue Act of 1967 and to prevent evasion of the retail 23 sales tax, it shall be presumed that all gross receipts are subject to 24 the tax until the contrary is established. The burden of proving that a sale of property is not a sale at retail is upon the person who makes the 25 26 sale unless he or she takes from the purchaser (i) a resale certificate 27 to the effect that the property is purchased for the purpose of reselling, leasing, or renting it, (ii) an exemption certificate pursuant 28 29 to subsection (7) of section 77-2705, or (iii) a direct payment permit 30 pursuant to sections 77-2705.01 to 77-2705.03. Receipt of a resale certificate, exemption certificate, or direct payment permit shall be 31

- 1 conclusive proof for the seller that the sale was made for resale or was
- 2 exempt or that the tax will be paid directly to the state.
- 3 (g) In the rental or lease of automobiles, trucks, trailers,
- 4 semitrailers, and truck-tractors as defined in the Motor Vehicle
- 5 Registration Act, the tax shall be collected by the lessor on the rental
- 6 or lease price, except as otherwise provided within this section.
- 7 (h) In the rental or lease of automobiles, trucks, trailers,
- 8 semitrailers, and truck-tractors as defined in the act, for periods of
- 9 one year or more, the lessor may elect not to collect and remit the sales
- 10 tax on the gross receipts and instead pay a sales tax on the cost of such
- 11 vehicle. If such election is made, it shall be made pursuant to the
- 12 following conditions:
- 13 (i) Notice of the desire to make such election shall be filed with
- 14 the Tax Commissioner and shall not become effective until the Tax
- 15 Commissioner is satisfied that the taxpayer has complied with all
- 16 conditions of this subsection and all rules and regulations of the Tax
- 17 Commissioner;
- 18 (ii) Such election when made shall continue in force and effect for
- 19 a period of not less than two years and thereafter until such time as the
- 20 lessor elects to terminate the election;
- 21 (iii) When such election is made, it shall apply to all vehicles of
- 22 the lessor rented or leased for periods of one year or more except
- 23 vehicles to be leased to common or contract carriers who provide to the
- 24 lessor a valid common or contract carrier exemption certificate. If the
- 25 lessor rents or leases other vehicles for periods of less than one year,
- 26 such lessor shall maintain his or her books and records and his or her
- 27 accounting procedure as the Tax Commissioner prescribes; and
- 28 (iv) The Tax Commissioner by rule and regulation shall prescribe the
- 29 contents and form of the notice of election, a procedure for the
- 30 determination of the tax base of vehicles which are under an existing
- 31 lease at the time such election becomes effective, the method and manner

for terminating such election, and such other rules and regulations as may be necessary for the proper administration of this subdivision.

3 (i) The tax imposed by this section on the sales of motor vehicles, semitrailers, and trailers as defined in sections 60-339, 60-348, and 4 5 60-354 shall be the liability of the purchaser and, with the exception of 6 motor vehicles, semitrailers, and trailers registered pursuant to section 7 60-3,198, the tax shall be collected by the county treasurer as provided 8 in the Motor Vehicle Registration Act or by an approved licensed dealer 9 participating in the electronic dealer services system pursuant to section 60-1507 at the time the purchaser makes application for the 10 11 registration of the motor vehicle, semitrailer, or trailer for operation 12 upon the highways of this state. The tax imposed by this section on motor vehicles, semitrailers, and trailers registered pursuant to section 13 14 60-3,198 shall be collected by the Department of Motor Vehicles at the 15 time the purchaser makes application for the registration of the motor vehicle, semitrailer, or trailer for operation upon the highways of this 16 17 state. At the time of the sale of any motor vehicle, semitrailer, or trailer, the seller shall (i) state on the sales invoice the dollar 18 amount of the tax imposed under this section and (ii) furnish to the 19 purchaser a certified statement of the transaction, in such form as the 20 21 Tax Commissioner prescribes, setting forth as a minimum the total sales 22 price, the allowance for any trade-in, and the difference between the 23 two. The sales tax due shall be computed on the difference between the 24 total sales price and the allowance for any trade-in as disclosed by such certified statement. Any seller who willfully understates the amount upon 25 26 which the sales tax is due shall be subject to a penalty of one thousand 27 dollars. A copy of such certified statement shall also be furnished to the Tax Commissioner. Any seller who fails or refuses to furnish such 28 29 certified statement shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon 30 conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars. If the purchaser does not 31

register such motor vehicle, semitrailer, or trailer for operation on the 1 2 highways of this state within thirty days of the purchase thereof, the 3 tax imposed by this section shall immediately thereafter be paid by the purchaser to the county treasurer or the Department of Motor Vehicles. If 4 5 the tax is not paid on or before the thirtieth day after its purchase, 6 the county treasurer or Department of Motor Vehicles shall also collect 7 from the purchaser interest from the thirtieth day through the date of 8 payment and sales tax penalties as provided in the Nebraska Revenue Act 9 of 1967. The county treasurer or Department of Motor Vehicles shall report and remit the tax so collected to the Tax Commissioner by the 10 11 fifteenth day of the following month. The county treasurer, for his or her collection fee, shall deduct and withhold for the use of the county 12 general fund, from all amounts required to be collected under this 13 14 subsection, the collection fee permitted to be deducted by any retailer 15 collecting the sales tax, all of which shall be deposited in the county general fund, plus one-half of one percent of all amounts in excess of 16 17 three thousand dollars remitted each month, seventy-five percent of which shall be deposited in the county general fund and twenty-five percent of 18 which shall be deposited in the county road fund. In any county with a 19 20 population of one hundred fifty thousand inhabitants or more, the county 21 treasurer shall remit one dollar of his or her collection fee for each of 22 the first five thousand motor vehicles, semitrailers, or trailers 23 registered with such county treasurer on or after the effective date of 24 this act to the State Treasurer for credit to the Department of Revenue Miscellaneous Receipts Fund. The Department of Motor Vehicles, for its 25 26 collection fee, shall deduct, withhold, and deposit in the Motor Carrier 27 Division Cash Fund the collection fee permitted to be deducted by any retailer collecting the sales tax. The collection fee for the county 28 29 treasurer or the Department of Motor Vehicles shall be forfeited if the 30 county treasurer or <u>department</u> Department of Motor Vehicles violates any rule or regulation pertaining to the collection of the use tax. 31

(j)(i) The tax imposed by this section on the sale of a motorboat as 1 defined in section 37-1204 shall be the liability of the purchaser. The 2 3 tax shall be collected by the county treasurer at the time the purchaser makes application for the registration of the motorboat. At the time of 4 5 the sale of a motorboat, the seller shall (A) state on the sales invoice 6 the dollar amount of the tax imposed under this section and (B) furnish 7 to the purchaser a certified statement of the transaction, in such form 8 as the Tax Commissioner prescribes, setting forth as a minimum the total 9 sales price, the allowance for any trade-in, and the difference between the two. The sales tax due shall be computed on the difference between 10 11 the total sales price and the allowance for any trade-in as disclosed by 12 such certified statement. Any seller who willfully understates the amount upon which the sales tax is due shall be subject to a penalty of one 13 14 thousand dollars. A copy of such certified statement shall also be 15 furnished to the Tax Commissioner. Any seller who fails or refuses to furnish such certified statement shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and 16 17 shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars. If the purchaser 18 does not register such motorboat within thirty days of the purchase 19 20 thereof, the tax imposed by this section shall immediately thereafter be 21 paid by the purchaser to the county treasurer. If the tax is not paid on 22 or before the thirtieth day after its purchase, the county treasurer 23 shall also collect from the purchaser interest from the thirtieth day 24 through the date of payment and sales tax penalties as provided in the Nebraska Revenue Act of 1967. The county treasurer shall report and remit 25 26 the tax so collected to the Tax Commissioner by the fifteenth day of the 27 following month. The county treasurer, for his or her collection fee, shall deduct and withhold for the use of the county general fund, from 28 29 all amounts required to be collected under this subsection, 30 collection fee permitted to be deducted by any retailer collecting the sales tax. The collection fee shall be forfeited if the county treasurer 31

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violates any rule or regulation pertaining to the collection of the use 1 2 tax.

3 (ii) In the rental or lease of motorboats, the tax shall be collected by the lessor on the rental or lease price. 4

5 (k)(i) The tax imposed by this section on the sale of an all-terrain 6 vehicle as defined in section 60-103 or a utility-type vehicle as defined 7 in section 60-135.01 shall be the liability of the purchaser. The tax 8 shall be collected by the county treasurer or by an approved licensed 9 dealer participating in the electronic dealer services system pursuant to section 60-1507 at the time the purchaser makes application for the 10 11 certificate of title for the all-terrain vehicle or utility-type vehicle. At the time of the sale of an all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type 12 vehicle, the seller shall (A) state on the sales invoice the dollar 13 14 amount of the tax imposed under this section and (B) furnish to the 15 purchaser a certified statement of the transaction, in such form as the Tax Commissioner prescribes, setting forth as a minimum the total sales 16 price, the allowance for any trade-in, and the difference between the 17 two. The sales tax due shall be computed on the difference between the 18 total sales price and the allowance for any trade-in as disclosed by such 19 certified statement. Any seller who willfully understates the amount upon 20 21 which the sales tax is due shall be subject to a penalty of one thousand 22 dollars. A copy of such certified statement shall also be furnished to 23 the Tax Commissioner. Any seller who fails or refuses to furnish such 24 certified statement shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not less than twenty-five 25 26 dollars nor more than one hundred dollars. If the purchaser does not 27 obtain a certificate of title for such all-terrain vehicle or utilitytype vehicle within thirty days of the purchase thereof, the tax imposed 28 29 by this section shall immediately thereafter be paid by the purchaser to 30 the county treasurer. If the tax is not paid on or before the thirtieth day after its purchase, the county treasurer shall also collect from the 31

- 1 purchaser interest from the thirtieth day through the date of payment and
- 2 sales tax penalties as provided in the Nebraska Revenue Act of 1967. The
- 3 county treasurer shall report and remit the tax so collected to the Tax
- 4 Commissioner by the fifteenth day of the following month. The county
- 5 treasurer, for his or her collection fee, shall deduct and withhold for
- 6 the use of the county general fund, from all amounts required to be
- 7 collected under this subsection, the collection fee permitted to be
- 8 deducted by any retailer collecting the sales tax. The collection fee
- 9 shall be forfeited if the county treasurer violates any rule or
- 10 regulation pertaining to the collection of the use tax.
- 11 (ii) In the rental or lease of an all-terrain vehicle or a utility-
- 12 type vehicle, the tax shall be collected by the lessor on the rental or
- 13 lease price.
- 14 (iii) County treasurers are appointed as sales and use tax
- 15 collectors for all sales of all-terrain vehicles or utility-type vehicles
- 16 made outside of this state to purchasers or users of all-terrain vehicles
- 17 or utility-type vehicles which are required to have a certificate of
- 18 title in this state. The county treasurer shall collect the applicable
- 19 use tax from the purchaser of an all-terrain vehicle or a utility-type
- 20 vehicle purchased outside of this state at the time application for a
- 21 certificate of title is made. The full use tax on the purchase price
- 22 shall be collected by the county treasurer if a sales or occupation tax
- 23 was not paid by the purchaser in the state of purchase. If a sales or
- 24 occupation tax was lawfully paid in the state of purchase at a rate less
- 25 than the tax imposed in this state, use tax must be collected on the
- 26 difference as a condition for obtaining a certificate of title in this
- 27 state.
- 28 (1) The Tax Commissioner shall adopt and promulgate necessary rules
- 29 and regulations for determining the amount subject to the taxes imposed
- 30 by this section so as to insure that the full amount of any applicable
- 31 tax is paid in cases in which a sale is made of which a part is subject

to the taxes imposed by this section and a part of which is not so subject and a separate accounting is not practical or economical.

- 3 (2) A use tax is hereby imposed on the storage, use, or other consumption in this state of property purchased, leased, or rented from 4 5 any retailer and on any transaction the gross receipts of which are 6 subject to tax under subsection (1) of this section on or after June 1, 7 1967, for storage, use, or other consumption in this state at the rate 8 set as provided in subsection (1) of this section on the sales price of 9 the property or, in the case of leases or rentals, of the lease or rental prices. 10
- 11 (a) Every person storing, using, or otherwise consuming in this 12 state property purchased from a retailer or leased or rented from another person for such purpose shall be liable for the use tax at the rate in 13 14 effect when his or her liability for the use tax becomes certain under 15 the accounting basis used to maintain his or her books and records. His or her liability shall not be extinguished until the use tax has been 16 paid to this state, except that a receipt from a retailer engaged in 17 18 business in this state or from a retailer who is authorized by the Tax Commissioner, under such rules and regulations as he or she may 19 prescribe, to collect the sales tax and who is, for the purposes of the 20 21 Nebraska Revenue Act of 1967 relating to the sales tax, regarded as a 22 retailer engaged in business in this state, which receipt is given to the 23 purchaser pursuant to subdivision (b) of this subsection, shall be 24 sufficient to relieve the purchaser from further liability for the tax to which the receipt refers. 25
- (b) Every retailer engaged in business in this state and selling, leasing, or renting property for storage, use, or other consumption in this state shall, at the time of making any sale, collect any tax which may be due from the purchaser and shall give to the purchaser, upon request, a receipt therefor in the manner and form prescribed by the Tax Commissioner.

- (c) The Tax Commissioner, in order to facilitate the proper 1 administration of the use tax, may designate such person or persons as he 2 3 or she may deem necessary to be use tax collectors and delegate to such persons such authority as is necessary to collect any use tax which is 4 5 due and payable to the State of Nebraska. The Tax Commissioner may 6 require of all persons so designated a surety bond in favor of the State 7 of Nebraska to insure against any misappropriation of state funds so 8 collected. The Tax Commissioner may require any tax official, city, 9 county, or state, to collect the use tax on behalf of the state. All persons designated to or required to collect the use tax shall account 10 11 for such collections in the manner prescribed by the Tax Commissioner. 12 Nothing in this subdivision shall be so construed as to prevent the Tax Commissioner or his or her employees from collecting any use taxes due 13 14 and payable to the State of Nebraska.
- 15 (d) All persons designated to collect the use tax and all persons required to collect the use tax shall forward the total of such 16 17 collections to the Tax Commissioner at such time and in such manner as the Tax Commissioner may prescribe. For all use taxes collected prior to 18 October 1, 2002, such collectors of the use tax shall deduct and withhold 19 20 from the amount of taxes collected two and one-half percent of the first 21 three thousand dollars remitted each month and one-half of one percent of 22 all amounts in excess of three thousand dollars remitted each month as 23 reimbursement for the cost of collecting the tax. For use taxes collected 24 on and after October 1, 2002, such collectors of the use tax shall deduct and withhold from the amount of taxes collected two and one-half percent 25 26 of the first three thousand dollars remitted each month as reimbursement 27 for the cost of collecting the tax. Any such deduction shall be forfeited to the State of Nebraska if such collector violates any rule, regulation, 28 29 or directive of the Tax Commissioner.
- 30 (e) For the purpose of the proper administration of the Nebraska 31 Revenue Act of 1967 and to prevent evasion of the use tax, it shall be

- 1 presumed that property sold, leased, or rented by any person for delivery
- 2 in this state is sold, leased, or rented for storage, use, or other
- 3 consumption in this state until the contrary is established. The burden
- 4 of proving the contrary is upon the person who purchases, leases, or
- 5 rents the property.
- 6 (f) For the purpose of the proper administration of the Nebraska
- 7 Revenue Act of 1967 and to prevent evasion of the use tax, for the sale
- 8 of property to an advertising agency which purchases the property as an
- 9 agent for a disclosed or undisclosed principal, the advertising agency is
- 10 and remains liable for the sales and use tax on the purchase the same as
- 11 if the principal had made the purchase directly.
