Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 109 would modify the position classification plan and the salary/pay plans for the Department of Correctional Services. The changes proposed would become effective for fiscal year 2021-22.

The specific classification changes would be to create three grades of "Corrections Corporal", three grades of "Corrections Sergeant", and three grades of "Corrections Unit Caseworker". Each of the grade levels would be assigned to a different pay grade within the salary or pay plan.
