Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 464 was introduced at the request of the state Risk Manager. The bill presents claims against the State which are required to be reviewed and appropriated by the Legislature.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 758 becomes the bill:

Section by Section summary:

Section 1: contains two miscellaneous claims to be paid out of the Department of Administrative Services Program 536.

Section 2: contains two tort claims to be paid out of the Department of Administrative Services Program 591.

Section 3: contains one indemnification claim to be paid out of the Department of Administrative Services Program 592.

Section 4: contains six workers compensation claims to be paid out of the Department of Administrative Services Program 593.

Section 5: contains three settlements to be paid by the Department of Administrative Services Program 594.

Section 6: authorizes and directs the Director of Administrative Services to draw upon the funds in this act.

Section 7: contains agency write-off requests from the Department of Veterans' Affairs, Department of Transportation, Nebraska Game and Parks Commission, Department of Health and Human Services, Nebraska Supreme Court, and the Department of Labor.

Section 8: emergency clause.
