Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 68 would allow cities to amend ordinances governing business improvement districts (BIDs) to change BID boundaries or change the functions or provisions of an existing BID. Currently, cities can only amend BID ordinances to expand the boundaries of an existing BID.

LB 68 would also make a number of clean-up and technical changes to the Business Improvement District Act.
