Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill would change provisions relating to enforcement of certain tobacco restriction provisions. The bill establishes a uniform process for tobacco compliance checks to be performed for the purpose of deterring licensees from providing nicotine products to persons under eighteen years of age. It provides that persons at least fifteen but under eighteen years old may assist law enforcement or a tobacco prevention coalition in conducting a compliance check with written consent of a parent or guardian.

The Judiciary Committee Statement explains the amendment as follows: AM 271 limits the compliance checks using minors (ages 15 to 18) to law enforcement agency efforts only (eliminating licensees, Department of Health and Human Services and coalition grantees, and the FDA in the original proposal). The amendment also prohibits using juveniles actively involved in a diversion program, on probation, or subject to a pending criminal proceeding.

The Supreme Court estimates no fiscal impact from this bill, as amended by AM271.

The State Patrol estimates no fiscal impact from this bill, as amended by AM2082.
