Section 3 requires any new state building to meet or exceed the requirements of the 2018 International Energy Conservation Code published by the International Code Council.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB 405 would adopt Chapter 13 of the 2018 International Building Code and all but Chapter 13 of the 2012 edition of the International Building Code. The bill adopts Chapter 11 of the 2018 International Residential Code and all but Chapter 11 of the 2012 edition of the International Residential Code. The bill updates the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC) to the 2018 IECC version. Furthermore, LB 405 also adopts a local energy code and requires counties, cities, and villages to notify the State Energy Office if it modifies its local codes by deleting any portion of Chapter 13 of the 2018 International Building Code or Chapter 11 of the 2018 International Residential Code.

LB 405 is primarily directed at local governments (e.g., International Residential Code). As with any bill that would change or update the state building code, there is a potential of increasing construction and design costs, but the fiscal impact cannot be determined at this time. However, any fiscal impact would likely be minimal and able to be absorbed with current resources.
