Explanation of Estimate:

One section of AM 514 requires the Secretary of State's office to conduct the Metropolitan Utility District (MUD) elections. There are three MUD seats up for election in 2020. The candidate filing fee is \$25, so our office should collect a minimum of \$75, but more likely will receive \$150 if there are at least two candidates per open seat. The 2021 MUD election will only have two open seats, so \$100 in filing fees are likely to be received.

We do not anticipate any significant additional expenses incurred as a result of this legislation as the MUD elections would simply be included as part of our normal election processes.
