Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill, as amended, would increase penalties for tampering with witnesses, informants, jurors, or physical evidence and change provisions relating to discovery in criminal cases.

The Supreme Court estimates a minimal fiscal impact from the provisions of this bill.

The Board of Parole estimates no significant impact from this bill.

The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) states that the bill has the potential to increase the length of time someone spends in prison for a tampering conviction if it is related to a Class I, IA, IB, IC, ID, or II felony. See the DCS response attached for additional details not included in this fiscal note.

Because this bill has the potential to increase the length of time someone spends in prison, this could have an impact on prison overcrowding. As of March 18, 2019, the prison population was 160% of design capacity. Additionally, DCS contracts with some counties to temporarily house prison inmates. If those inmates are included in the prison population numbers, then the prison population would be 163% of design capacity.

If the impact of this bill is to increase the length of time someone spends in prison, DCS could incur additional per diem costs. The FY18 per diem cost for an individual inmate was \$8,226 per year, which includes NDCS inmates in county jails.

Lancaster County states that the provision allowing police reports to be available per discovery request may result in more preliminary hearings. The reason is that currently the parties often agree to waive preliminary hearings in exchange for police reports. This provision would not change the number of cases but it would increase the amount of court time for attorneys. They estimate needing an additional Deputy County Attorney and a one-half time Paralegal for \$126,260 in FY20 and \$131,462 in FY21. Explanation of Estimate:

The tampering portion of the statute should not affect Lancaster County Attorney's Office to any significant degree.

The change to the discovery statute, in Sec. 4. Section 29-1912 adding paragraph Reports developed or received by law enforcement agencies when such reports directly relate to the investigation of the underlying charge or charges in the case;

may add significant cost for the Lancaster County Attorney's Office. We filed approximately 2500 felony cases in 2018. Often, we agree to waive Preliminary Hearings in exchange for police reports. If these reports are available per a discovery request, I anticipate more preliminary hearings will be held. If the preliminary hearings increase by only 10% that is an additional 250 preliminary hearings a year, or approximately 21 additional hearings a month. Although this change will not add to case number it will add to court time for attorneys. I would need an additional attorney, \$95,100.00, for the increase in court time, and a half time paralegal, \$31,160.00, to cover the increase in hearing prep and witness notifications. Total of \$126,260.00, for the first year and \$131,462.50 for FY 2020-21. Total for biennium \$257,722.50.
