A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to crimes and offenses; to amend sections 28-115 and 28-310.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to prohibit assault by strangulation or suffocation as prescribed; to provide for an enhanced penalty for assault by strangulation or suffocation of a pregnant woman; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original sections.

7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 28-115, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 2 amended to read: 3 28-115 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, any person who commits any of the following criminal offenses against a 4 5 pregnant woman shall be punished by the imposition of the next higher penalty classification than the penalty classification prescribed for the 6 7 criminal offense: 8 (a) Assault in the first degree, section 28-308; 9 (b) Assault in the second degree, section 28-309; 10 (c) Assault in the third degree, section 28-310; (d) Assault by strangulation or suffocation, section 28-310.01; 11 (e) (d) Sexual assault in the first degree, section 28-319; 12 (f) (e) Sexual assault in the second or third degree, section 13 28-320; 14 (g) (f) Sexual assault of a child in the first degree, section 15 28-319.01; 16 17 (h) (g) Sexual assault of a child in the second or third degree, section 28-320.01; 18 19 (i) (h) Sexual abuse of an inmate or parolee in the first degree, section 28-322.02; 20 (i) (i) Sexual abuse of an inmate or parolee in the second degree, 21 22 section 28-322.03; (k) (j) Sexual abuse of a protected individual in the first or 23 24 second degree, section 28-322.04; 25 (1) (k) Domestic assault in the first, second, or third degree, section 28-323; 26 (m) (1) Assault on an officer, an emergency responder, a state 27 correctional employee, a Department of Health and Human Services 28 employee, or a health care professional in the first degree, section 29 28-929; 30 (n) (m) Assault on an officer, an emergency responder, a state 31

8 <u>(p)</u> (0) Assault on an officer, an emergency responder, a state 9 correctional employee, a Department of Health and Human Services 10 employee, or a health care professional using a motor vehicle, section 11 28-931.01;

12 (q) (p) Assault by a confined person, section 28-932;

<u>(r)</u> (q) Confined person committing offenses against another person,
 section 28-933; and

(s) (r) Proximately causing serious bodily injury while operating a
 motor vehicle, section 60-6,198.

17 (2) The enhancement in subsection (1) of this section does not apply 18 to any criminal offense listed in subsection (1) of this section that is 19 already punishable as a Class I, IA, or IB felony. If any criminal 20 offense listed in subsection (1) of this section is punishable as a Class 21 I misdemeanor, the penalty under this section is a Class IIIA felony.

(3) The prosecution shall allege and prove beyond a reasonable doubtthat the victim was pregnant at the time of the offense.

24 Sec. 2. Section 28-310.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 25 amended to read:

28-310.01 (1) A person commits the offense of <u>assault by</u>
 27 strangulation <u>or suffocation</u> if the person knowingly <u>and intentionally:</u>
 28 or

29 (a) Impedes intentionally impedes the normal breathing or 30 circulation of the blood of another person by applying pressure on the 31 throat or neck of the other person; or -

(b) Impedes the normal breathing of another person by covering the
 mouth and nose of the person.

3 (2) An offense is committed under this section regardless of whether
4 a visible injury resulted.

5 (3) (2) Except as provided in subsection (4) (3) of this section, <u>a</u>
6 violation of this section strangulation is a Class IIIA felony.

7 (4) A violation of this section (3) Strangulation is a Class IIA
8 felony if:

9 (a) The person used or attempted to use a dangerous instrument while 10 committing the offense;

(b) The person caused serious bodily injury to the other person while committing the offense; or

13 (c) The person has been previously convicted of <u>a violation of this</u>
 14 <u>section strangulation</u>.

(5) (4) It is an affirmative defense that an act constituting
 strangulation <u>or suffocation</u> was the result of a legitimate medical
 procedure.
