- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Volunteer Emergency Responders
 Incentive Act; to amend sections 77-3104 and 77-3105, Reissue
 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change and eliminate provisions
 relating to notice, reporting, the approval and certification of
 volunteer members who are eligible for a tax credit, and the
 claiming of the tax credit; to provide an operative date; and to
 repeal the original sections.

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1 Section 1. Section 77-3104, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 77-3104 (1) Each volunteer department serving a county, city,
- 4 village, or rural or suburban fire protection district shall designate
- 5 one member of the department to serve as the certification administrator.
- 6 The designation of such individual as the certification administrator
- 7 shall be confirmed and approved by the governing body of such county,
- 8 city, village, or rural or suburban fire protection district. The
- 9 certification administrator shall keep and maintain records on the
- 10 activities of all volunteer members and award points for such activities

(2) No later than July 15 of each year, the The certification

- 17 emergency responders, active rescue squad members, or active volunteer

- 19 later than February 15. The certification administrator shall also send a
- 20 copy of such certified list to the governing body of the county, city,

- 23 (2) <u>Each</u> For taxable years beginning or deemed to begin on or after
- 24 January 1, 2017, under the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended,
- 25 each volunteer member on the list described in subsection (1) of this
- 26 section shall receive a refundable credit against the income tax imposed
- 27 by the Nebraska Revenue Act of 1967 in an amount equal to two hundred
- 28 fifty dollars beginning with the second taxable year in which such
- 29 volunteer <u>member</u> is included on such list. <u>The volunteer member shall</u>
- 30 claim the credit by including a copy of the certification received under
- 31 subsection (3) of section 77-3104 with the volunteer member's state

- 1 <u>income tax return.</u>
- 2 Sec. 3. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2020.
- 3 Sec. 4. Original sections 77-3104 and 77-3105, Reissue Revised
- 4 Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
