Section 1. Section 27-801, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 27-801 The following definitions apply under this article:

4 (1) A statement is (a) an oral or written assertion or (b) nonverbal 5 conduct of a person, if it is intended by him <u>or her</u> as an assertion;

(2) A declarant is a person who makes a statement;

7 (3) Hearsay is a statement, other than one made by the declarant
8 while testifying at the trial or hearing, offered in evidence to prove
9 the truth of the matter asserted; and

10 (4) A statement is not hearsay if:

(a) The declarant testifies at the trial or hearing and is subject 11 to cross-examination concerning the statement, and the statement is (i) 12 is inconsistent with his or her testimony and was given under oath 13 subject to the penalty of perjury at a trial, hearing, or other 14 proceeding, or in a deposition, or (ii) <u>is</u> consistent with his or her 15 testimony and is offered to rebut an express or implied charge against 16 him or her of recent fabrication or improper influence or motive, or 17 (iii) ide<u>ntifies a person as someone the declarant perceived earlier; or</u> 18

(b) The statement is offered against a party and is (i) his or her 19 own statement, in either his or her individual or a representative 20 capacity, Θr (ii) a statement of which he <u>or she</u> has manifested his <u>or</u> 21 <u>her</u> adoption or belief in its truth, Θr (iii) a statement by a person 22 authorized by him or her to make a statement concerning the subject, or 23 24 (iv) a statement by his or her agent or servant within the scope of his or her agency or employment, or (v) a statement by a coconspirator of a 25 party during the course and in furtherance of the conspiracy. 26
