- 21 <u>respective names, upon the presentation of proper vouchers therefor. The</u>
- 22 <u>several amounts appropriated in this act shall be in full payment of any</u>
- 23 and all claims, rights, causes of action, damages, and demands of every
- 24 <u>character and kind owing by or against the State of Nebraska, its</u>
- 25 officers, agents, and employees, and their successors and assigns with
- 26 respect to each of the beneficiaries respectively in whose favor the
- 27 appropriations are made. The director shall not deliver any warrant for
- 28 any items appropriated in this act until a receipt and release in full,
- 29 releasing the State of Nebraska, its officers, employees, and agents, and
- 30 their successors and assigns, has been filed by each of the beneficiaries
- 31 <u>respectively</u>. Upon presentation of the warrants, the State Treasurer is

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- 1 hereby directed to pay the same out of money in the General Fund or out
- 2 of money in other funds indicated in this act not otherwise appropriated.

- 17 Sec. 8. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 18 passed and approved according to law.
