- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to postsecondary education; to require public
- 2 postsecondary institutions to submit reports regarding sexual
- 3 harassment; to require public hearings as prescribed; and to define
- 4 terms.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

LB534 2020

- 1 Section 1. (1) On or before September 15, 2021, and September 15 of
- 2 <u>each odd-numbered year thereafter, each public postsecondary institution</u>
- 3 shall electronically submit a report regarding sexual harassment and
- 4 Title IX compliance to the Clerk of the Legislature and the Education
- 5 <u>Committee of the Legislature. The report shall include:</u>
- 6 (a) Results of any campus climate survey related to sexual
- 7 harassment;
- 8 (b) Information related to the training provided to Title IX
- 9 coordinators, investigators, and decisionmakers regarding sexual
- 10 harassment;
- 11 (c) Any policies, initiatives, or grievance procedures the
- 12 postsecondary institution has adopted to address sexual harassment;
- 13 (d) Information on where the postsecondary institution's students
- 14 <u>and employees may receive immediate emergency assistance to address</u>
- 15 instances of sexual harassment;
- 16 (e) Information on how the postsecondary institution's students and
- 17 <u>employees may report concerns of sexual harassment to the postsecondary</u>
- 18 institution;
- 19 <u>(f) Information on resources, programs, and support available to the</u>
- 20 postsecondary institution's students and employees to address concerns of
- 21 <u>sexual harassment;</u>
- 22 (g) Information on any of the postsecondary institution's student or
- 23 employee-led organizations engaged in supporting victims of sexual
- 24 <u>harassment; a</u>nd
- 25 (h) Any agreement between the postsecondary institution and a local
- 26 <u>law enforcement agency or the county attorney related to addressing</u>
- 27 instances of sexual harassment.
- 28 (2) The report shall not include any personally identifiable
- 29 <u>information</u>, <u>information that is subject to a privilege arising under</u>
- 30 state or federal law, or records that may be withheld from disclosure
- 31 under section 84-712.05.

- 1 (3) On or before December 15, 2021, and on or before December 15 of
- 2 <u>each odd-numbered year thereafter, the Education Committee of the</u>
- 3 <u>Legislature shall hold a public hearing to review all reports submitted</u>
- 4 under this section.
- 5 <u>(4) For purposes of this section:</u>
- 6 (a) Postsecondary institution has the same meaning as in section
- 7 85-2403;
- 8 (b) Sexual harassment means conduct that satisfies one or more of
- 9 <u>the following:</u>
- 10 (i) An employee conditioning the provision of an aid, benefit, or
- 11 service on an individual's participation in unwelcome sexual conduct;
- 12 (ii) Unwelcome conduct on the basis of sex determined by a
- 13 reasonable person to be so severe, pervasive, and objectively offensive
- 14 that it effectively denies a person equal access to the education program
- 15 or activity;
- (iii) Sexual assault as defined in 20 U.S.C. 1092(f)(6)(A)(v);
- 17 (iv) Dating violence as defined in 34 U.S.C. 12291(a)(10);
- 18 (v) Domestic violence as defined in 34 U.S.C. 12291(a)(8); or
- 19 <u>(vi) Stalking as defined in 34 U.S.C. 12291(a)(30); and</u>
- 20 (c) Title IX means Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972,
- 21 Public Law 92-318, 20 U.S.C. 1681 to 1688, and its accompanying
- 22 regulations and guidance documents, as amended.
