- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to insurance; to prohibit denial of coverage
- for mental health services delivered in a school; to define terms;
- 3 and to provide for applicability.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section:
- 2 (a) Health insurance policy means (i) any individual or group
- 3 sickness and accident insurance policy or subscriber contract delivered,
- 4 issued for delivery, or renewed in this state and any hospital, medical,
- 5 <u>or surgical expense-incurred policy, except for a policy that provides</u>
- 6 coverage for a specified disease or other limited-benefit coverage, and
- 7 (ii) any self-funded employee benefit plan to the extent not preempted by
- 8 federal law; and
- 9 <u>(b) School means a public, private, denominational, or parochial</u>
- 10 school which meets the requirements for accreditation or approval
- 11 prescribed in Chapter 79.
- 12 (2) Notwithstanding section 44-3,131, an insurer offering a health
- 13 <u>insurance policy shall not deny coverage or payment for a mental health</u>
- 14 service solely because the service is delivered in a school.
- 15 (3) Nothing in this section shall:
- 16 (a) Require an insurer offering a health insurance policy to pay for
- 17 mental health services that are otherwise excluded from such health
- 18 insurance policy;
- 19 (b) Require an insurer offering a health insurance policy to pay for
- 20 mental health services that are provided by an individual employed by or
- 21 under contract with a school district or an educational service unit in a
- 22 regular full-time or part-time position; or
- 23 <u>(c) Prevent application of any other provision of such health</u>
- 24 <u>insurance policy</u>.
- 25 (4) This section applies to health insurance policies issued or
- 26 renewed on or after January 1, 2020, and to claims for reimbursement
- 27 <u>based on such policies for costs incurred on or after January 1, 2020.</u>
