- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 53-502, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2018, is amended to read:
- 3 53-502 (1) Within thirty days after the appointment of the initial
- 4 members of the Nebraska Craft Brewery Board, such board shall conduct its
- 5 first regular meeting. During that meeting, the board members shall elect
- 6 from among themselves, by majority vote, a chairperson, vice-chairperson,
- 7 secretary, and treasurer, all to serve for terms of one year from the
- 8 date of election. Subsequent board meetings shall take place at least
- 9 once every six months and at such times as called by the chairperson or
- 10 by any three board members.
- 11 (2) Each member shall serve for a term of three years, except that
- 12 at the expiration of the terms of the members in 2022, the Governor shall
- 13 appoint two members for a term of one year, two members for a term of two
- 14 years, and three members for a term of three years, and their successors
- shall be appointed for a term of three years. Upon completion of a term,
- 16 a member may, at the Governor's discretion, and may be reappointed.
- 17 (3) All voting members of the board shall be reimbursed for their
- 18 actual and necessary expenses incurred while engaged in the performance
- 19 of official responsibilities as members of such board pursuant to
- 20 sections 81-1174 to 81-1177.
- 21 (4) A member may be removed by the Governor for cause. The member
- 22 shall first be given a written copy of the charges against him or her and
- 23 also an opportunity to be heard publicly. If a member moves out of
- 24 Nebraska, that shall be deemed sufficient cause for removal from office.
