- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend
- 2 section 60-6,233, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to allow
- 3 physician medical directors to display certain vehicle lights as
- 4 prescribed; to define a term; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 60-6,233, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 60-6,233 (1)(a) A rotating or flashing red light or lights or such
- 4 light or lights in combination with a blue light or lights may be
- 5 displayed on any motor vehicle operated by any volunteer firefighter, or
- 6 peace officer, or physician medical director anywhere in this state while
- 7 actually en route to the scene of a fire or other emergency requiring his
- 8 or her services as a volunteer firefighter, or peace officer, or
- 9 physician medical director, but only after its use has been authorized in
- 10 writing by the county sheriff and, with respect to a physician medical
- 11 <u>director</u>, <u>such person has successfully completed an emergency vehicle</u>
- 12 <u>operator course</u>.
- 13 (b) Application for a permit to display such light shall be made in
- 14 writing to the sheriff on forms to be prescribed and furnished by the
- 15 Superintendent of Law Enforcement and Public Safety. The application
- 16 shall be accompanied by a statement that the applicant is a volunteer
- 17 firefighter, or peace officer, or physician medical director and is
- 18 requesting issuance of the permit. The statement shall be signed by the
- 19 applicant's superior.
- (c) The permit shall be carried at all times in the vehicle named in
- 21 the permit. Each such permit shall expire on December 31 of each year and
- 22 shall be renewed in the same manner as it was originally issued.
- 23 (d) The sheriff may at any time revoke such permit upon a showing of
- 24 abuse thereof or upon receipt of notice from the applicant's superior
- 25 that the holder thereof is no longer an active volunteer firefighter, or
- 26 peace officer, or physician medical director. Any person whose permit has
- 27 been so revoked shall upon demand surrender it to the sheriff or his or
- 28 her authorized agent.
- 29 (2) A rotating or flashing red light or lights or such light or
- 30 lights in combination with a blue light or lights may be displayed on any
- 31 motor vehicle being used by rescue squads actually en route to, at, or

- 1 returning from any emergency requiring their services, or by any
- 2 privately owned wrecker when engaged in emergency services at the scene
- 3 of an accident, or at a disabled vehicle, located outside the city limits
- 4 of a city of the metropolitan or primary class, but only after its use
- 5 has been authorized in writing by the county sheriff. Applications shall
- 6 be made and may be revoked in the same manner as for volunteer
- 7 firefighters as provided in subsection (1) of this section.
- 8 (3) For purposes of this section, physician medical director has the
- 9 same meaning as in section 38-1210.
