- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to workers' compensation; to amend section
- 2 48-162, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to change and provide
- 3 powers relating to the contempt power of the Nebraska Workers'
- 4 Compensation Court; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the
- 5 original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 48-162, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 48-162 (1) The Nebraska Workers' Compensation Court, or any judge
- 4 thereof, is authorized and empowered to examine under oath or otherwise
- 5 any person, employee, employer, agent, superintendent, supervisor, or
- 6 officer of any partnership, limited liability company, or corporation,
- 7 any officer of any domestic insurance company, any agent of any foreign
- 8 insurance company, or any medical practitioner, to issue subpoenas for
- 9 the appearance of witnesses and the production of books and papers, to
- 10 solemnize marriages, and to administer oaths with like effect as is done
- 11 in other courts of law in this state. In the examination of any witness
- 12 and in requiring the production of books, papers, and other evidence, the
- 13 compensation court shall have and exercise all of the powers of a judge,
- 14 magistrate, or other officer in the taking of depositions or the
- 15 examination of witnesses, including the power to enforce his or her
- 16 orders by commitment for refusal to answer or for the disobedience of any
- 17 such order.
- 18 (2) The compensation court or any judge thereof may, upon the motion
- 19 of either party or upon its or his or her own motion, require the
- 20 production of any books, documents, payrolls, medical reports, X-rays,
- 21 photographs, or plates or any facts or matters which may be necessary to
- 22 assist in a determination of the rights of either party in any matter
- 23 pending before the compensation court or any judge thereof.
- 24 (3) The compensation court or any judge thereof may issue contempt
- 25 orders in accordance with sections 25-2121 to 25-2123. Any such contempt
- 26 order of the compensation court shall be enforced in accordance with
- 27 <u>section 48-188.</u>
- 28 (4) (3) The compensation court or any judge thereof may expedite the
- 29 hearing of a disputed case when there is an emergency.
