1	Section 1. (1) The Department of Health and Human Services shall
2	<u>contract for the completion of a needs assessment and cost analysis for</u>
3	the establishment of an inpatient adolescent psychiatric unit housed
4	within the Lincoln Regional Center. The department shall contract with an
5	outside consultant with expertise in cost and needs analysis of health
6	care facilities within sixty days after the effective date of this act
7	for the purpose of conducting such analysis.
8	(2) The department shall submit a report electronically to the
9	Health and Human Service Committee of the Legislature and the Clerk of
10	the Legislature on or before October 15, 2020. Such report shall contain
11	the following information:
12	(a) A needs assessment, including the number of adolescents expected
13	to use such inpatient psychiatric unit;
14	(b) The cost of opening an existing facility at the Lincoln Regional
15	<u>Center for use as an inpatient adolescent psychiatric unit;</u>
