- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to economic development; to adopt the H3 Rural
- 2 Renewal Award Act; to provide duties for the Department of Labor; to
- 3 create funds; to provide for termination.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Sections 1 to 8 of this act shall be known and may be

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- 2 cited as the H3 Rural Renewal Award Act.
- 3 Sec. 2. The Legislature finds and declares that:
- 4 (1) Nebraska has experienced population loss in fifty-seven of the
- 5 ninety-three counties;
- 6 (2) Surveys show that young professionals who have moved to other
- 7 states within the last ten years have done so for the betterment of their
- 8 professional lives; and
- 9 (3) In the Planning Committee 2019 Annual Report, the Nebraska
- 10 Legislature's Planning Committee recommends that the Legislature focus on
- 11 policies that drive workers into H3 jobs and reverse depopulation in
- 12 <u>rural counties as ways to reduce brain drain and advance economic and</u>
- 13 <u>community development.</u>
- 14 Sec. 3. For purposes of the H3 Rural Renewal Award Act:
- 15 (1) Department means the Department of Labor;
- 16 (2) Eligible individual means any person that:
- 17 (a)(i) Attended a postsecondary institution and earned an associate,
- 18 bachelor's, or post-graduate degree; or
- 19 <u>(ii) Completed an apprenticeship or other professional program and</u>
- 20 <u>obtained a certificate that allows such person to work in an H3 job;</u>
- 21 <u>(b) Has established and is maintaining his or her domicile in a</u>
- 22 <u>rural county;</u>
- 23 (c) Is employed in an H3 job;
- 24 (d) Applies for an award under the act within five years after
- 25 obtaining such degree or certificate and provides proof of his or her
- 26 hourly wage; and
- 27 (e) Commits to maintain his or her domicile in such rural county for
- 28 two months for each month an award is received pursuant to the act;
- 29 <u>(3) H3 job means a job in a high wage, high skill, and high demand</u>
- 30 <u>occupation as determined by the department;</u>
- 31 (4) High demand means the number of annual openings, net change in

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1 employment, and growth rate indicate high demand as determined by the

- 2 department;
- 3 (5) High skill means:
- 4 (a) At least some postsecondary education is required; or
- 5 (b) A high school diploma, or equivalent, plus long-term, on-the-job
- 6 training, an apprenticeship, or an internship or residency is required;
- 7 (6) High wage means a wage that equals or exceeds wages for all
- 8 <u>occupations in the same region in at least four of eight wage metrics as</u>
- 9 determined by the department;
- 10 (7) New money means a contribution to a qualified endowment
- 11 generated after August 1, 2020;
- 12 (8) Postsecondary institution means any institution with a physical
- 13 presence in Nebraska that provides postsecondary education pursuant to
- 14 the Postsecondary Institution Act or the Private Postsecondary Career
- 15 School Act;
- 16 (9) Qualified endowment means an endowment that:
- 17 (a) Meets the standards set by the Department of Labor;
- 18 (b) Is intended for long-term stabilization of the H3 Rural Renewal
- 19 Award Endowment Fund; and
- 20 <u>(c) Has the funds of the endowment endowed and only the earnings</u>
- 21 <u>thereon are available to be expended; and</u>
- 22 (10) Rural county means any county of this state that has
- 23 experienced a five-year net population decline over the closest five-year
- 24 period for which information is available.
- 25 Sec. 4. (1) The purpose of the H3 Rural Renewal Award Act is to
- 26 attract qualified workers to H3 jobs in parts of this state experiencing
- 27 <u>population loss and a shortage of skilled workers and to alleviate the</u>
- 28 <u>burden left on such qualified workers from the cost of education and</u>
- 29 training. The department shall pay monthly awards to eligible individuals
- 30 from the H3 Rural Renewal Award Cash Fund as provided in this section.
- 31 (2) On or before January 1 each year, the Department of Labor shall

- 1 publish a list of rural counties for purposes of the act.
- 2 (3) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (4) of this section,
- 3 each eligible individual shall receive an award equal to;
- 4 (a) If the hourly wage for the eligible individual is forty dollars
- 5 or more, one hundred dollars per month;
- 6 (b) If the hourly wage for the eligible individual is thirty-five
- 7 dollars or more and less than forty dollars, one hundred fifty dollars
- 8 per month;
- 9 (c) If the hourly wage for the eligible individual is thirty dollars
- or more and less than thirty-five dollars, two hundred dollars per month;
- 11 (d) If the hourly wage for the eligible individual is twenty-five
- 12 <u>dollars or more and less than thirty dollars, two hundred fifty dollars</u>
- 13 per month;
- 14 <u>(e) If the hourly wage for the eligible individual is twenty dollars</u>
- 15 or more and less than twenty-five dollars, three hundred dollars per
- 16 month;
- 17 (f) If the hourly wage for the eligible individual is fifteen
- 18 dollars or more and less than twenty dollars, three hundred fifty dollars
- 19 per month; or
- 20 (g) If the hourly wage is less than fifteen dollars, four hundred
- 21 <u>dollars per month.</u>
- 22 (4) If there is not sufficient money available in the H3 Rural
- 23 Renewal Award Cash Fund for all awards to be paid in any month, all
- 24 awards to be paid in such month shall be proportionally reduced such that
- 25 the total for all awards is equal to the money available in the H3 Rural
- 26 Renewal Award Cash Fund for such month.
- 27 <u>(5) Each award shall be paid on the last business day of each month</u>
- 28 from the H3 Rural Renewal Award Cash Fund for a total of twenty-four
- 29 months.
- 30 (6)(a) Any award recipient who does not meet the eligibility
- 31 criteria at the time a payment is made under this section shall be

- 1 required to refund such payment to the department.
- 2 (b) Any award recipient who does not maintain his or her domicile in
- 3 the required rural county for the required number of months shall repay
- 4 awards for the number of required months that such award recipient did
- 5 not maintain his or her domicile in the required rural county.
- 6 (7) The department shall establish an application procedure,
- 7 <u>application deadlines, repayment procedures, and any other procedures</u>
- 8 <u>necessary to carry out the act.</u>
- 9 <u>(8) The department shall assist rural counties to publicize the</u>
- 10 grant program to potential eligible individuals.
- 11 Sec. 5. (1) The H3 Rural Renewal Award Endowment Fund is created.
- 12 The fund shall consist of donations and money appropriated by the
- 13 <u>Legislature</u>. Only the earnings of the fund may be used as provided in
- 14 this section.
- 15 (2) On August 1, 2020, the State Treasurer shall transfer two
- 16 <u>million dollars from the General Fund to the H3 Rural Renewal Award</u>
- 17 Endowment Fund.
- 18 (3) Except as provided in subsection (4) of this section, it is the
- 19 <u>intent of the Legislature that the State Treasurer shall transfer an</u>
- 20 <u>amount not to exceed one million dollars from the General Fund to the H3</u>
- 21 Rural Renewal Award Endowment Fund annually on December 31 beginning in
- 22 2021 and continuing through December 31, 2030.
- 23 (4) Prior to the transfer of funds from any state account into the
- 24 H3 Rural Renewal Award Endowment Fund, the Department of Labor shall
- 25 provide documentation to the budget division of the Department of
- 26 <u>Administrative Services that qualified endowments have generated a</u>
- 27 dollar-for-dollar match of new money, up to the amount of state funds
- 28 authorized by the Legislature to be transferred to the H3 Rural Renewal
- 29 Award Endowment Fund. Contributions not fully matched by state funds
- 30 shall be carried forward to succeeding years and remain available to
- 31 provide a dollar-for-dollar match for state funds. The budget division of

- 1 the Department of Administrative Services shall notify the State
- 2 Treasurer to execute a transfer of state funds up to the amount specified
- 3 by the Legislature, but only to the extent that the Department of Labor
- 4 has provided documentation of a dollar-for-dollar match. State funds not
- 5 transferred shall be carried forward to the succeeding year and be added
- 6 to the funds authorized for a dollar-for-dollar match during that year.
- 7 (5) The Legislature shall not appropriate or transfer money from the
- 8 H3 Rural Renewal Award Endowment Fund except as provided in this section.
- 9 (6) Any money in the H3 Rural Renewal Award Endowment Fund available
- 10 for investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant
- 11 <u>to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds</u>
- 12 <u>Investment Act.</u>
- 13 <u>(7) All investment earnings from the H3 Rural Renewal Award</u>
- 14 Endowment Fund shall be credited to the H3 Rural Renewal Award Cash Fund
- on a monthly basis.
- 16 (8) Any money in the fund on January 1, 2031, or upon termination of
- 17 <u>the act if earlier than January 1, 2031, shall be transferred to the</u>
- 18 permanent school fund described in section 79-1035.01.
- 19 Sec. 6. <u>(1) The H3 Rural Renewal Award Cash Fund is created. The</u>
- 20 <u>fund shall consist of earnings transferred from the H3 Rural Renewal</u>
- 21 Award Endowment Fund pursuant to section 5 of this act and shall be
- 22 administered by the department. The department shall use the H3 Rural
- 23 Renewal Award Cash Fund to carry out the H3 Rural Renewal Award Act. The
- 24 Legislature shall not appropriate or transfer money from the fund for any
- 25 purpose except as provided in the act.
- 26 (2) Any money in the fund available for investment shall be invested
- 27 by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital
- 28 Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- 29 (3) Any money in the fund on January 1, 2031, or upon termination of
- 30 the act if earlier than January 1, 2031, shall be transferred to the
- 31 permanent school fund described in section 79-1035.01.

- 1 Sec. 7. The department may adopt and promulgate rules and
- 2 <u>regulations to carry out the H3 Rural Renewal Award Act and to administer</u>
- 3 the H3 Rural Renewal Award Endowment Fund and the H3 Rural Renewal Award
- 4 <u>Cash Fund.</u>
- 5 Sec. 8. The H3 Rural Renewal Award Act shall terminate on January
- 6 1, 2031.
