Section 1. Section 71-439, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 71-439 (1) The Legislature adopts the 2018 Guidelines for Design and Construction of Hospitals, the 2018 Guidelines for Design and 4 Construction of Outpatient Facilities, and the 2018 Guidelines for Design 5 and Construction of Residential Health, Care, and Support Facilities 6 published by the Facility Guidelines Institute for the construction of 7 any health care facility on or after the effective date of this act and 8 9 for any major addition, remodeling, restoration, repair, or renovation of any health care facility on or after the effective date of this act as 10 determined by the department. 11

(2) The department may waive any rule, regulation, or standard 12 adopted and promulgated by the department relating to construction or 13 physical plant requirements of a licensed health care facility or health 14 care service upon proof by the licensee satisfactory to the department 15 (a) that such waiver would not unduly jeopardize the health, safety, or 16 welfare of the persons residing in or served by the facility or service, 17 (b) that such rule, regulation, or standard would create an unreasonable 18 hardship for the facility or service, and (c) that such waiver would not 19 cause the State of Nebraska to fail to comply with any applicable 20 requirements of medicare or medicaid so as to make the state ineligible 21 for the receipt of all funds to which it might otherwise be entitled. 22

(3) (2) In evaluating the issue of unreasonable hardship, the
 department shall consider the following:

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(a) The estimated cost of the modification or installation;

(b) The extent and duration of the disruption of the normal use of
areas used by persons residing in or served by the facility or service
resulting from construction work;

(c) The estimated period over which the cost would be recovered
through reduced insurance premiums and increased reimbursement related to
cost;

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1 (d) The availability of financing; and

2 (e) The remaining useful life of the building.

3 <u>(4)</u> (3) Any such waiver may be granted under such terms and 4 conditions and for such period of time as provided in rules and 5 regulations adopted and promulgated by the department.
