- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Tree Recovery Program; to
- 2 amend sections 72-1901, 72-1902, and 72-1904, Reissue Revised
- 3 Statutes of Nebraska; to change legislative findings, intent
- 4 relating to appropriations, and application deadlines; and to repeal
- 5 the original sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 72-1901, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 72-1901 The Legislature finds that, due to severe weather
- 4 conditions, invasive species, and diseases, cities and villages across
- 5 Nebraska are experiencing tree mortality. Most cities and villages have
- 6 been unable to act decisively and preventively due to insufficient funds
- 7 to remove, dispose of, and replace trees situated on public land. Dead
- 8 trees are fast becoming a liability and a safety problem for cities and
- 9 villages.
- 10 Sec. 2. Section 72-1902, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 11 amended to read:
- 12 72-1902 It is the intent of the Legislature that three million two
- 13 hundred fifty thousand dollars be appropriated from the General Fund for
- 14 fiscal year 2019-2020 and for each fiscal year thereafter until the
- 15 Legislature finds that ash trees are no longer a safety issue for cities
- 16 and villages, 1994-95 for a program to fund tree removal, disposal, and
- 17 replacement costs. The Nebraska Forest Service of the University of
- 18 Nebraska Institute of Agriculture and Natural Resources Department of
- 19 Forestry, Fisheries and Wildlife shall administer the program through a
- 20 grant process, and the program shall be known as the Nebraska Tree
- 21 Recovery Program. The Nebraska Community Forestry Council shall act as an
- 22 advisory body in administration of the program. The service shall adopt
- 23 and promulgate rules and regulations necessary to carry out sections
- 24 72-1901 to 72-1904.
- 25 Sec. 3. Section 72-1904, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 26 amended to read:
- 27 72-1904 Applications for grants for the first year of the Nebraska
- 28 Tree Recovery Program shall be received each year by a date established
- 29 <u>by</u> not later than July 1, 1994, and grants shall be awarded not later
- 30 than October 1, 1994. In subsequent years the Nebraska Forest Service of
- 31 the University of Nebraska Institute of Agriculture and Natural Resources

- 1 Department of Forestry, Fisheries and Wildlife shall establish the date
- 2 by which applications must be submitted, and grants shall be awarded not
- 3 later than ninety days after such date.
- 4 The following shall be considered in reviewing a proposal of an
- 5 applicant for a grant from the program:
- 6 (1) Grant money shall be used to plant, or remove, or dispose of
- 7 <u>only those</u> trees <u>located</u> only on land owned by state or local
- 8 governments, including parks, public grounds, and city rights-of-way;
- 9 (2) Trees shall be purchased from commercial Nebraska nurseries;
- 10 (3) The applicant shall provide funds to match the grant at a fifty-
- 11 fifty match rate;
- 12 (4) Local labor may be considered as in-kind participation in
- 13 calculating the amount of the applicant's matching funds required by
- 14 subdivision (3) of this section;
- 15 (5) No state or local funds under the program shall be used to
- 16 purchase real property;
- 17 (6) Tree species to be planted under the proposal shall be adaptable
- 18 to Nebraska and the local area in order for such trees to grow and
- 19 thrive;
- 20 (7) Arboricultural experts may be consulted at the local and state
- 21 levels for expertise in developing local tree replanting programs;
- 22 (8) Local programs shall indicate a partnership between the
- 23 applicant and property owners showing how to best replant and maintain
- 24 trees for the first three years after planting; and
- 25 (9) Cities, villages, civic groups, students, and families should be
- 26 involved in selecting, replanting, and caring for trees for the valuable
- 27 educational aspects of the program.
- 28 Sec. 4. Original sections 72-1901, 72-1902, and 72-1904, Reissue
- 29 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
