Section 1. Section 71-503.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,
 is amended to read:

3 physician, a physician 71-503.02 If а assistant, a nurse 4 practitioner, or a certified nurse midwife licensed under the Uniform 5 Credentialing Act diagnoses a patient as having chlamydia, or gonorrhea, or trichomoniasis, the physician may prescribe, provide drug samples of, 6 or dispense pursuant to section 38-2850, and the physician assistant, 7 nurse practitioner, or certified nurse midwife may prescribe or provide 8 9 drug samples of, prescription oral antibiotic drugs to that patient's 10 sexual partner or partners without examination of that patient's partner or partners. Adequate directions for use and medication guides, where 11 applicable, shall be provided along with additional prescription oral 12 antibiotic drugs for any additional partner. The physician, physician 13 assistant, nurse practitioner, or certified nurse midwife shall at the 14 same time provide written information about chlamydia, and gonorrhea, and 15 16 trichomoniasis to the patient for the patient to provide to the partner 17 or partners. The oral antibiotic drugs prescribed, provided, or dispensed pursuant to this section must be stored, dispensed, and labeled in 18 19 accordance with federal and state pharmacy laws and regulations. Prescriptions for the patient's sexual partner or partners must include 20 the partner's name. If the infected patient is unwilling or unable to 21 deliver such prescription oral antibiotic drugs to his or her sexual 22 23 partner or partners, such physician may prescribe, provide, or dispense pursuant to section 38-2850 and 24 such physician assistant, nurse 25 practitioner, or certified nurse midwife may prescribe or provide samples of the prescription oral antibiotic drugs for delivery to such partner, 26 if such practitioner has sufficient locating information. 27
