8	(1) Administer the Nebraska Visitors Development Act;

3 <u>(14)</u> (13) Develop and administer a program to provide promotional 4 services, technical assistance, and state aid to local governments and 5 the tourism industry;

6 (15) (14) Establish written policies and procedures governing the
7 executive director and the personnel of the commission in the expenditure
8 and use of funds appropriated to the commission;

9 <u>(16)</u> (15) Cooperate with federal, state, and local governments and 10 private individuals and organizations to carry out any of the functions 11 of the commission and purposes of the Nebraska Visitors Development Act; 12 and

13 (17) (16) Actively coordinate and develop working partnerships with 14 other state agencies, including, but not limited to, the Commission on 15 Indian Affairs, the Department of Economic Development, the Game and 16 Parks Commission, the Nebraska Arts Council, the Nebraska State 17 Historical Society, and the University of Nebraska.

Sec. 3. <u>The commission is authorized to develop and make available</u> for sale directly to the public tourism promotional products related to state marketing campaigns developed and approved by the commission. The commission may contract with private vendors to produce, sell, and distribute such tourism promotional products. Any revenue from the sale of such tourism promotional products shall be credited to the Nebraska Tourism Commission Promotional Cash Fund as provided in section 81-3728.

Sec. 4. Section 81-3728, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
26 2018, is amended to read:

27 81-3728 Vendors under contract with the commission to develop,
28 print, and distribute publications and promotional materials <u>or produce</u>,
29 <u>sell, and distribute tourism promotional products</u> on behalf of the
30 commission shall, on a monthly basis, submit to the commission all
31 revenue received from the sale of advertising space in such publications

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<u>or from the sale of such tourism promotional products</u>. Monthly submissions shall include an itemization of the sources of revenue in a format as designated by the commission. Revenue shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Nebraska Tourism Commission Promotional Cash Fund.

Sec. 5. Original sections 81-3701, 81-3711, and 81-3728, Revised
7 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018, are repealed.
