- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to telecommunications; to prohibit the
- 2 selling, renting, or conveying of telephone numbers as prescribed;
- 3 to Adopt the Neighbor Spoofing Protection Act; and to provide a
- 4 civil penalty.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) This section shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 <u>Neighbor Spoofing Protection Act.</u>
- 3 (2) No person shall sell, rent, or convey any interest in a
- 4 telephone number to any out-of-state person unless such telephone number
- 5 <u>is listed or available from directory assistance to the general public so</u>
- 6 <u>that a member of the general public could determine the source of the</u>
- 7 <u>telephone number by contacting his or her telecommunications provider.</u>
- 8 (3) Subsection (2) of this section shall not apply if such telephone
- 9 number is:
- 10 (a) Used to provide access to tone-controlled devices for which
- 11 <u>restricted access to the numbering resource is justified for security or</u>
- 12 <u>functional purposes;</u>
- 13 (b) Used for any authorized activity of a law enforcement agency; or
- (c) Required to be unlisted by court order.
- 15 (4) No person shall, in connection with any telecommunications
- 16 service or IP-enabled voice service, cause any caller identification
- 17 <u>service to knowingly transmit misleading or inaccurate caller</u>
- 18 <u>identification information with the intent to defraud, cause harm, or</u>
- 19 wrongfully obtain anything of value.
- 20 <u>(5) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent or</u>
- 21 restrict any person from blocking the capability of any caller
- 22 identification service to transmit caller identification information.
- 23 (6) This section shall not apply:
- 24 (a) To any authorized activity of a law enforcement agency; or
- 25 (b) When a court order specifically authorizes the use of caller
- 26 identification manipulation.
- 27 <u>(7) Except as provided in this section, local exchange carriers and</u>
- 28 <u>telecommunications carriers shall not be responsible for enforcement of</u>
- 29 this section.
- 30 (8)(a) Notwithstanding section 75-156, the Public Service Commission
- 31 may, after hearing, impose an administrative penalty for a violation of

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- 1 this section. The penalty for a violation shall not exceed two thousand
- 2 <u>dollars</u>. Every violation associated with a specific telephone number
- 3 within the state shall be considered a separate and distinct violation.
- 4 (b) The amount of an administrative penalty shall be based on:
- 5 (i) The nature, circumstances, extent, and gravity of a prohibited
- 6 <u>act;</u>
- 7 (ii) The history of previous violations;
- 8 (iii) The amount necessary to deter future violations; and
- 9 (iv) Any efforts to correct the violation.
- 10 (c) The commission shall remit any administrative penalty collected
- 11 <u>under this section to the State Treasurer for distribution in accordance</u>
- 12 <u>with Article VII, section 5, of the Constitution of Nebraska.</u>
- 13 (d) Any administrative penalty may be appealed. The appeal shall be
- 14 <u>in accordance with section 75-136.</u>
