 functions by certified pharmacy technicians as prescribed; to
 harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original sections.

Supervision of a pharmacy technician may occur by means of a real-time audiovisual communication system. 19 Validation means the action of a certified pharmacy 20 Sec. 4. 21 technician checking the accuracy and completeness of the acts, tasks, or 22 functions undertaken by another certified pharmacy technician as provided in section 5 of this act. 23 (1) A pharmacy technician may validate the tasks and 24 Sec. 5. 25 functions of another pharmacy technician only if: (a) Both pharmacy technicians are certified by a state or national 26 certifying body which is approved by the board; 27 28 (b) Working within the confines of a hospital; (c) Using bar code technology, radio frequency identification 29 30 technology, or similar technology to validate the accuracy of medication; (d) Validating medication that is prepackaged by the manufacturer or 31

1 prepackaged and verified by a pharmacist; and

2 (e) Acting in accordance with policies and procedures applicable in
3 the hospital established by the pharmacist in charge.

4 (2) The pharmacist in charge in a hospital shall establish policies
5 and procedures for validation of medication by two or more certified
6 pharmacy technicians before such validation process is implemented in the
7 hospital.
