- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Grape and Winery Board; to
- 2 amend section 53-302, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
- 3 change provisions relating to terms of office; and to repeal the
- 4 original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 53-302, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 53-302 (1) Within thirty days after the appointment of the initial
- 4 members of the Nebraska Grape and Winery Board, such board shall conduct
- 5 its first regular meeting. During that meeting, the board members shall
- 6 elect from among themselves, by majority vote, a chairperson, vice-
- 7 chairperson, secretary, and treasurer, all to serve for terms of one year
- 8 from the date of election. Subsequent board meetings shall take place at
- 9 least once every six months and at such times as called by the
- 10 chairperson or by any three board members.
- 11 (2) Each board member shall serve for a term of three years, except
- 12 that at the expiration of the terms of the members in 2021, the Governor
- 13 <u>shall appoint one member for a term of one year, two members for a term</u>
- 14 of two years, and two members for a term of three years, and their
- 15 successors shall be appointed for a term of three years. Upon upon
- 16 completion of <u>a term, a member</u> which he or she may, at the Governor's
- 17 discretion, be reappointed.
- 18 (3) All voting board members shall be reimbursed for their actual
- 19 and necessary expenses, as provided for in sections 81-1174 to 81-1177,
- 20 while attending meetings of the board or while engaged in the performance
- 21 of official responsibilities as determined by the board.
- 22 (4) A board member shall be removable by the Governor for cause. The
- 23 board member shall first be given a written copy of the charges against
- 24 him or her and also an opportunity to be heard publicly. In addition to
- 25 all other causes, the failure of a board member to continue to meet any
- 26 of the requirements for eligibility set out in section 53-301 shall be
- 27 deemed sufficient cause for removal from office.

- 29 Nebraska, is repealed.
