1 Section 1. Section 54-909, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 54-909 (1) If a person is convicted of a Class IV felony under
- 4 section 54-903, the sentencing court shall order such person not to own
- 5 or possess a livestock animal or an animal as defined by section 28-1008
- 6 for at least five years after the date of conviction, but such time
- 7 restriction shall not exceed fifteen years. Any person violating such
- 8 court order shall be guilty of a Class I misdemeanor.
- 9 (2) If a person is convicted of a Class I misdemeanor under section
- 10 54-903 or a Class III misdemeanor under section 54-904, the sentencing
- 11 court may order such person not to own or possess any livestock animal or
- 12 <u>animal as defined by section 28-1008</u> after the date of conviction, but
- 13 such time restriction, if any, shall not exceed five years. Any person
- 14 violating such court order shall be guilty of a Class IV misdemeanor.
- 15 (3) Any livestock animal or animal as defined by section 28-1008
- 16 involved in a violation of a court order under subsection (1) or (2) of
- 17 this section shall be subject to seizure by law enforcement.
