## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 81**

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Rules of the Road; to amend
- 2 sections 60-6,170, 60-6,172, 60-6,173, and 60-6,174, Reissue Revised
- 3 Statutes of Nebraska, and sections 60-601 and 60-605, Revised
- 4 Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018; to define a term; to change
- 5 provisions relating to special stops at railroad grade crossings; to
- 6 harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original sections.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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1 Section 1. Section 60-601, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,

- 2 2018, is amended to read:
- 3 60-601 Sections 60-601 to 60-6,383 <u>and section 3 of this act</u>shall
- 4 be known and may be cited as the Nebraska Rules of the Road.
- 5 Sec. 2. Section 60-605, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 6 2018, is amended to read:
- 7 60-605 For purposes of the Nebraska Rules of the Road, the
- 8 definitions found in sections 60-606 to 60-676 and section 3 of this act
- 9 shall be used.
- 10 Sec. 3. <u>On-track equipment means any railroad locomotive or any</u>
- 11 <u>other car, rolling stock, equipment, or other device operated upon</u>
- 12 <u>stationary rails either alone or coupled to other railroad locomotives,</u>
- 13 <u>cars, rolling stock, equipment, or devices.</u>
- 14 Sec. 4. Section 60-6,170, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 15 amended to read:
- 16 60-6,170 (1) Whenever any person driving a vehicle approaches a
- 17 railroad grade crossing under any of the circumstances set forth in this
- 18 section, the driver of such vehicle shall stop within fifty feet but not
- 19 less than fifteen feet from the nearest rail of such railroad and shall
- 20 not proceed until he or she can do so safely. The requirements of this
- 21 subsection shall apply when:
- 22 (a) A clearly visible electric or mechanical signal device gives
- 23 warning of the immediate approach of a railroad train or on-track
- 24 <u>equipment</u>;
- 25 (b) A crossing gate is lowered or a flagperson gives or continues to
- 26 give a signal of the approach or passage of a railroad train or on-track
- 27 <u>equipment</u>;
- 28 (c) A railroad train or on-track equipment approaching within
- 29 approximately one-quarter mile of the highway crossing emits a signal
- 30 audible from such distance and such railroad train or on-track equipment,
- 31 by reason of its speed or nearness to such crossing, is an immediate

- 1 hazard; or
- 2 (d) An approaching railroad train <u>or on-track equipment</u> is plainly
- 3 visible and is in hazardous proximity to such crossing.
- 4 (2) No person shall drive any vehicle through, around, or under any
- 5 crossing gate or barrier at a railroad crossing while such gate or
- 6 barrier is closed or is being opened or closed.
- 7 Sec. 5. Section 60-6,172, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 8 amended to read:
- 9 60-6,172 (1) The driver of any bus carrying passengers for hire or
- 10 of any school bus, before crossing at grade any track of a railroad,
- 11 shall stop such vehicle within fifty feet but not less than fifteen feet
- 12 from the nearest rail of such railroad and while so stopped shall listen
- 13 and look in both directions along such track for any approaching railroad
- 14 train or on-track equipment and for signals indicating the approach of a
- 15 railroad train or on-track equipment, except as otherwise provided in the
- 16 Nebraska Rules of the Road. The driver shall not proceed until he or she
- 17 can do so safely. After stopping as required by this section and upon
- 18 proceeding when it is safe to do so, the driver of any such vehicle shall
- 19 cross only in such gear of the vehicle that there will be no necessity
- 20 for changing gears while traversing such track and the driver shall not
- 21 shift gears while crossing such track.
- 22 (2) No stop shall be made at any such crossing when a peace officer
- 23 or a flagperson directs traffic to proceed or at an abandoned or exempted
- 24 grade crossing which is clearly marked as such by or with the consent of
- 25 competent authority when such markings can be read from the driver's
- 26 position.
- Sec. 6. Section 60-6,173, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 28 amended to read:
- 29 60-6,173 (1) The driver of any vehicle which is required to be
- 30 placarded pursuant to section 75-364, before crossing at a grade any
- 31 track of a railroad on streets and highways, shall stop such vehicle not

- 1 more than fifty feet nor less than fifteen feet from the nearest rail or
- 2 railroad and while stopped shall listen and look in both directions along
- 3 the track for an approaching railroad train or on-track equipment. The
- 4 driver shall not proceed until precaution has been taken to ascertain
- 5 that the course is clear.
- 6 (2) The requirements of subsection (1) of this section shall not 7 apply:
- 8 (a) When a peace officer or a flagperson directs traffic to proceed;
- 9 (b) At an abandoned or exempted grade crossing which is clearly
- 10 marked as such by or with the consent of competent authority when such
- 11 markings can be read from the driver's position; or
- 12 (c) At railroad tracks used exclusively for industrial switching
- 13 purposes within a business district.
- 14 (3) Nothing in this section shall be deemed to exempt the driver of
- 15 any vehicle from compliance with the other requirements contained in the
- 16 Nebraska Rules of the Road.
- 17 Sec. 7. Section 60-6,174, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 18 amended to read:
- 19 60-6,174 (1) No person shall operate or move any crawler-type
- 20 tractor, any steam shovel, any derrick, any roller, or any equipment or
- 21 structure having a normal operating speed of ten miles per hour or less
- 22 or a vertical body or load clearance of less than one-half inch per foot
- 23 of the distance between any two adjacent axles or in any event of less
- 24 than nine inches, measured above the level surface of a roadway, upon or
- 25 across any track at a railroad grade crossing without first complying
- 26 with this section.
- 27 (2) Before making any such crossing, the person operating or moving
- 28 any such vehicle or equipment shall first stop the same not less than
- 29 fifteen feet nor more than fifty feet from the nearest rail of such
- 30 railroad and while so stopped shall listen and look in both directions
- 31 along such track for any approaching railroad train or on-track equipment

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- 1 and for signals indicating the approach of a <u>railroad</u> train<u>or on-track</u>
- 2 <u>equipment</u>. The person shall not proceed until the crossing can be made
- 3 safely.
- 4 (3) No such crossing shall be made while warning is given by an
- 5 automatic signal, by crossing gates, by a flagperson, or otherwise of the
- 6 immediate approach of a railroad train or on-track equipment or car. If a
- 7 flagperson is provided by the railroad, movement over the crossing shall
- 8 be under his or her direction.
- 9 Sec. 8. Original sections 60-6,170, 60-6,172, 60-6,173, and
- 10 60-6,174, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, and sections 60-601 and
- 11 60-605, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2018, are repealed.
