Section 1. Section 25-328, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

25-328 Any person who has or claims an interest in the matter in litigation, in the success of either of the parties to an action, or against both, in any action pending or to be brought in any of the courts of the State of Nebraska, may become a party to an action between any other persons or corporations:

8 (1) By , either by joining the plaintiff in claiming what is sought 9 by the complaint,  $\Theta r$  by uniting with the defendants in resisting the 10 claim of the plaintiff, or by demanding anything adversely to both the 11 plaintiff and defendant, either before or after issue has been joined in 12 the action, and before the trial commences; or -

<u>(2) As provided in section 2 of this act.</u>

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in any 14 Sec. 2. proceeding in any court involving a juvenile who is in the custody of the 15 State of Nebraska for one of the reasons stated in section 43-247, a 16 person claiming to be a biological parent of such juvenile may file a 17 complaint to intervene in such proceeding. The complaint shall be 18 accompanied by an affidavit stating, under oath, that the affiant 19 believes he or she is a biological parent of such juvenile. No filing fee 20 shall be charged relating to such complaint and affidavit. Upon the 21 filing of such complaint and affidavit, the court shall order a DNA test 22 to be conducted and shall order that the juvenile be made available for 23 24 such DNA testing, both at the expense of the intervenor.
