**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 192 would allow the words "Reserve-Veteran" to be placed on the front of an operator license or state identification card of an individual who served in the army, air force, navy, marine or coast guard reserves but was not called to active duty. The words "Guard-Veteran" would be allowed to be placed on the front of an operator license or state identification card of an individual who served in the national guard but was not called to active duty.

The bill would also allow the word "Veteran" to be placed on the front of an operator license or state identification card of an individual who served as a commissioned officer in the U.S. Public Health Service or National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration.

The provisions in LB 192 would not determine veteran status for any other purpose.
