created. The fund shall be under the direction of the committee and shall 5

administered by the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary 6

Education. The fund shall consist of money received pursuant to section 7

9-812, any other money received by the state in the form of grants or 8

9 gifts from nonfederal sources, such other amounts as may be transferred

or otherwise accrue to the fund, and any investment income earned on the 10

fund. The fund shall be used to carry out the community college gap 11

assistance program provide aid or grants to the community colleges

pursuant to the Community College Gap Assistance Program Act. Any money 13

in the fund available for investment shall be invested by the state 14

investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the 15

Nebraska State Funds Investment Act. 16
