3 Section 1. Section 60-3,191, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

5 60-3,191 (1) In addition to any other fee required under the Motor 6 Vehicle Registration Act, a fee for registration of each motor vehicle 7 powered by an alternative fuel shall be charged. The fee shall be 8 seventy-five dollars. The fee shall be collected by the county treasurer 9 and remitted to the State Treasurer for credit to the Highway Trust Fund.

10 (2) Beginning January 1, 2027, this section shall not apply to any
 11 motor vehicle powered exclusively by electric energy.

2. On or before October 1, 2025, the Department of 12 Sec. 13 Transportation and the Department of Revenue shall jointly report to the Transportation and Telecommunications Committee of the Legislature and 14 the Revenue Committee of the Legislature the recommendations and proposed 15 legislation of the departments for the purpose of administering a 16 kilowatt-hour excise tax to be assessed on electric energy used to charge 17 and power electric motor vehicles used on public highways in Nebraska. 18

Sec. 3. Nothing in Chapter 70 shall preclude or prevent any entity doing business in the State of Nebraska from selling electric power at retail solely for the purpose of charging electric motor vehicles. Any entity engaged in the retail sale of electric power for such purpose shall collect a per-kilowatt-hour excise tax on the electric energy used in charging electric motor vehicles and remit such tax to the Department of Revenue for credit to the Highway Trust Fund.

26 Sec. 4. Section 3 of this act becomes operative on July 1, 2026. 27 The other sections of this act become operative on their effective date.
