## AMENDMENTS TO LB91

Introduced by Agriculture.

1. On page 2, line 9, strike the new matter and reinstate the 1 stricken matter. 2 3 2. On page 4, strike lines 12 through 15 and insert the following new subdivisions: 4 5 "(19) Native plant species means any grass, sedge, rush, or forb 6 indigenous to North America prior to European settlement; 7 (20) Nonnative plant species means any grass, sedge, rush, or forb not indigenous to North America prior to European settlement;". 8 3. On page 9, strike beginning with "or" in line 24 through 9 "ischaemum)" in line 25. 10 4. On page 16, strike lines 19 through 31, show the old matter as 11 stricken, and insert the following new subdivisions: 12 13 "(a)(i) Of a native plant species unless a test required by section 81-2,147.02 to determine the percentage of germination or a test to 14 determine the percentage of viability as indicated by a tetrazolium (TZ) 15 test has been completed within a twelve-month period, exclusive of the 16 calendar month in which the test was completed, immediately prior to 17 sale. Seeds packaged in hermetically sealed containers under the 18 19 conditions established in rules and regulations may be sold for a period 20 of thirty-six months after the last day of the month that the seeds were 21 tested prior to packaging. If the seeds in hermetically sealed containers are sold more than thirty-six months after the last day of the month in 22 which they were tested prior to packaging, they shall have been retested 23 for germination or retested for viability as indicated by a tetrazolium 24 (TZ) test within a nine-month period, exclusive of the calendar month in 25 which the retest was completed, immediately prior to their sale; and 26 27 (ii) Of a nonnative plant species unless a test required by section 1 <u>81-2,147.02 to determine the percentage of germination completed</u>".

5. On page 17, lines 1 through 3, 15, and 16, strike the new matter.
6. On page 20, strike beginning with "<u>described</u>" in line 24 through
"the" in line 25, show the old matter as stricken, and insert "<u>for which</u>
<u>a</u>".
