#### GENERAL FILE: CONSENT CALENDAR

The following rules apply to Consent Calendar:

- 1) If any three members of the Legislature object to the bill being considered on Consent Calendar, please advise the Clerk in writing. Such requests must be filed with the Clerk prior to the expiration of 15 minutes of debate, at this stage of consideration, on the bill to be removed.
- 2) Upon either the completion of debate or the expiration of 15 minutes, whichever comes first, a vote shall be taken to advance the bill and on any pending motions or amendments pursuant to Rule 5, Section 6(d).
- 3) Any amendment adopted, other than the standing committee amendment, which adds new subject matter to the bill will result in the bill not being scheduled at the next stage of debate.
- LB 847 (Wishart) Redefine political subdivision under the Political Subdivisions Construction Alternatives Act
- LB 567 (Business and Labor Committee) Change provisions relating to the maximum annual amount of benefits under the Employment Security Law
- LB 434 *(Revenue Committee)* Change provisions relating to tax expenditure reports and certain joint hearings of legislative committees
- LB 749 *(Friesen)* Change an identification inspection provision under the Motor Vehicle Certificate of Title Act
- LB 704 (Williams) Change education requirements for licensure under the Funeral Directing and Embalming Practice Act and eliminate certain provisions regarding caskets
