Currently - through July 1, 2021 - The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) cannot add long-term care services and supports to the Medicaid managed care programs. Long-term care and supports include skilled nursing facilities, nursing facilities, assisted-living facilities, and home and community-based services.

LB 101 would change the date to July 1, 2023.
