Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1178 would require that county assessors and registers of deeds withhold address information for judges who request that their residential address be withheld from the public. Judges submitting such a request to a county would be required to indicate "the name of the specific court of which he or she is a judge." "Judge" is defined so as to include judges and magistrate judges from any county court, any district court, the Court of Appeals, the Workers' Compensation Court, separate juvenile courts, the Supreme Court, and any federal court.
