Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1189 would provide that if a sanitary drainage district which lies solely within the zoning jurisdiction of a city is discontinued, all funds, property, property rights, legal obligations, taxes, or assessments owned by or owed to the district shall revert to the city or a riverfront development authority created by the city.

Representing:

Under the bill, a riverfront development authority shall only take title to and ownership of property or property rights of the discontinued sanitary drainage district contained within the boundaries of the riverfront development district managed by the authority.
