Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB1250 makes adjustments to the Property tax Request Act (Act).

Joint Public Hearing

- The joint public hearing shall be held before any of the participating political subdivisions adopt their budget.
- The joint public hearing shall be organized by the county clerk or his/her designee.

Postcard Information

- The county assessor shall send the information required to be included on the postcards to a printing service designated by the county board.
- The initial cost for printing the postcards shall be paid from the county general fund.
- The cost of creating and mailing the postcards, including staff time, materials and postage shall be charged proportionately to the political subdivisions participating in the joint public hearing.
- The proportionate share will be based on the total number of parcels in each participating political subdivisions.

 Clarifying language on the statement on the postcard will now indicate the proposed revenue increase will result in an overall increase in property taxes. The following statement will be added in all capital letters: "The actual tax on your property may increase or decrease." Explanation of amendments: The amendment strikes the new matter on page 2, lines 26 and 27, and reinstates the original deadlines from last year's LB664.
