Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill amends the powers of the Nebraska Tourism Commission to provide that the Commission may engage directly with retailers for the sale of tourism promotional products. It further provides that retailers who pay in full for merchandise have no further reporting requirements to the Commission. The bill also makes harmonizing changes in a section of statute governing the handling of sales revenue received by the Commission and in a section of statute describing the powers of the Commission.
