Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB615, introduced by Senator Erdman, changes the way the Game and Parks Commissioners become members of the commission. Instead of being appointed by the Governor with the approval of the Legislature, LB615 requires that beginning in 2022, commissioners will be elected statewide on a nonpartisan ballot. Under LB615, members meeting the qualifications of Section 37-101(1) and who derive fifty percent or more of their income from agriculture may be elected to serve staggered terms on the commission.
