**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

The bill amends subsection (b)(3) of Section 60-146.

The subsection currently provides that county sheriff's shall enter into agreements with new and used motor vehicle dealers in the sheriff's county of jurisdiction to collect information for vehicle title inspections at the dealer's business location.

Currently the subsection provides that sheriff's are required to collect title information at the time of sale of the motor vehicle.

The bill amends and clarifies the subsection to provide that sheriffs shall collect title information for motor vehicles at any time the motor vehicle is held in the dealer's inventory.

The bill adds the Emergency Clause.
